The Bison picked up a pair of shutout victories last week ... In a 2-0 victory at Chatham, **Missy Gibson** had a goal and an assist, and **Megan Maloney** tallied the other goal ... In the Bradford triumph, Gibson had another three point day, assisting on a **Bethany Mucho** goal and scoring her own early in the second half ... She now has 37 career goals (tied for fourth all-time) and 91 career points (fourth all-time) ... The other goals against Bradford were the first collegiate scores for freshmen **Anna Ruggiero** and **Jen Burin** ... Goalkeeper **Maggie Kuhn** stopped four shots in each win to record the shutouts.
