The Bison picked up a pair of shutout victories last week ... In a 2-0 victory at Chatham, Missy Gibson had a goal and an assist, and Megan Maloney tallied the other goal ... In the Bradford triumph, Gibson had another three point day, assisting on a Bethany Mucho goal and scoring her own early in the second half ... She now has 37 career goals (tied for fourth all-time) and 91 career points (fourth all-time) ... The other goals against Bradford were the first collegiate scores for freshmen Anna Ruggiero and Jen Burin ... Goalkeeper Maggie Kuhn stopped four shots in each win to record the shutouts.

W&J dropped a pair of contests over the weekend in Ohio, falling to Case Western Reserve and Hiram ... Case Western jumped out to a 3-0 lead in the first half on Saturday and never looked back in shutting out the Presidents, 5-0 ... Sophomore Gretchen Weber made 12 saves in the net for W&J ... On Sunday, Hiram once again took a 3-0 halftime lead only to see the Presidents come back to tie the game on a second-half hat trick by freshman Jen Pergola ... Pergola scored three goals in a 15-minute span of the half, however, Hiram ended the game with six minutes left in the second OT ... Junior Kristina Meshanko and freshmen Sandy Simoneaux and Toni Lynn Simonini all added one assist in the game, while Weber made 12 saves.

Grove City Wolverines

Lady Wolverines opened season with pair of victories, including double-overtime victory at Hope Friday afternoon ... Michelle Novosel and Meg Tilley both posted hat tricks in the victory over La Roche while Tilley scored the game-winner at Hope on a rebound ...
