# **Bethany Bison**

Bethany went 0-2 at the Frostburg State Women's Soccer 10-Year Anniversary Tournament over the weekend, losing to the host Bobcats by a score of 12-0 then falling to Catholic University by a score of 4-0 ... The Bison hung tough, trailing by a score of 1-0 at halftime, but Catholic tallied three second half goals to put the game out of reach ... The Bison were out-shot in the two games by a total of 81-6 ... Bison freshman GK Jessica Alloggia played all 90 minutes in both games and accumulated 29 total saves ... She stopped a career-high 13 shots against Frostburg, then set a new career best with 16 saves against Catholic.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The W&J women's soccer team picked up its first two wins of the season on a road trip to North Carolina this past weekend ... The Presidents defeated Greensboro (N.C.), 1-0, on Friday afternoon and then edged Piedmont (N.C.) by the same score on Saturday ... In the win over Greensboro, sophomore MF Rachel Moses scored the game's only goal with 15 minutes remaining in the first half ... Junior F Jen Pergola assisted on the goal ... Sophomore GK Marguerite Egan recorded the shutout after making seven saves ... Pergola then scored the lone goal versus Piedmont on Saturday off an assist from freshman MF Kallen Frey ... W&J senior GK Gretchen Weber stopped all five shots on goal to earn the shutout.

# **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City did not score in three matches last week, falling to 2-4 on the season ... Sophomore goalkeeper **Kori Koper** had a career-high 14 saves Friday at Fredonia State in Fredonia's Days Inn Classic ... She also stopped seven shots in Grove City's 1-0 loss to Capital in the consolation match ... The last time Grove City lost three straight matches, the Wolverines responded with a 15-match win streak ... Grove City hosts Penn State-Behrend Wednesday.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg recorded a 7-2 victory in the opening round of the Yellow Jacket Shootout to give first-year head coach Jim Rue his first collegiate victory ... Junior Jackie Sassaman recorded two goals and two assists in the opener to help lead the Jackets past Mt. Aloysius ... Also scoring two goals for the Jackets was freshman GK Adrienne Campbell ... Her goals came on her only two shots of the contest in which she also recorded an assist, in addition to playing net for four minutes ... Erin Mali scored a goal and recorded an assist in the victory ... Kate Zimmerman and Ashley Elliot each notched Jacket goals in the opener ... Waynesburg was overpowered by Baldwin Wallace, which won the championship game 3-0.
