Pergola led W&J to a 2-0 week with wins over La Roche (3-2 in OT) and Carlow (12-1) with five goals and one assist for 11 points. She scored two goals (including the game-winner in OT) and assisted on the other against La Roche, then had a first-half hat trick in the Carlow victory.

Also nominated was senior GK Maggie Kuhn of Bethany, sophomore GK Lindsay Thompson of Grove City, junior MF Katie Mound of Thiel, freshman MF Morgan Smoke of Waynesburg, and senior MF Alyssa Pyle of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany fell to 0-4 on the year with a pair of home losses last week ... Pitt-Greensburg outshot Bethany 27-6 in the Bison's 3-0 loss ... GK Maggie Kuhn made 18 saves in the game... The roles were somewhat reversed in the Thiel loss... The Green and White outshot the Lady Cats 15-7 but could not get that elusive first goal... A Thiel goal in the 74th minute proved to be enough to send the Bison to 0-4... Bethany has now gone more than 364 minutes without a goal this season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J picked up a pair of wins this week, defeating La Roche and Carlow ... Sophomore F Jen Pergola scored five goals in the two contests, including two against La Roche ... Pergola sent the Presidents home a winner with a goal two minutes into the first overtime period on Wednesday ... She also assisted on the Presidents' second goal by freshman F Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli ... The 12 goals scored by W&J on Saturday was the second-most in school history and the most since a 13-1 rout of Chatham in 1995 ... Pergola netted a hat trick in the first half as W&J scored six goals in both halves ... Loffreda-Mancinelli finished with two goals and two assists, while freshman F Rachel Moses also posted two helpers to go with one goal ... Freshman MF Katie Orient also supplied two goals in the second half.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a pair of home matches this week to two regional rivals ... Junior Michelle Novosel accounted for Grove City's lone goal during the week, a 20-yard blast late in Saturday's loss to John Carroll ... Sophomore Lindsay Thompson stopped seven shots against John Carroll ... She also stopped eight shots in 77 minutes against Carnegie Mellon ... The Lady Wolverines go on the road for the first time this season Thursday at Allegheny before returning home for two non-league home matches with Mount Union and Frostburg State.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg shutout both Chatham and D'Youville—the only two teams it defeated last year—improving one goal on each team from a year ago ... In 2002, the Jackets shutout Chatham 6-0 and D'Youville 7-0, while this year Waynesburg won 7-0 and 8-0 ... Freshman MF Morgan Smoke had 11 points (3 goals and 5 assists) for the week, while junior MF Jackie Sassaman had 9 points (4 goals and 1 assist) ... Smoke had seven points against Chatham with three assists to go with her two goals and finding the back of the net on three shots ... Sassaman and Tara Pagone also had two-goal games against Chatham ... Sassaman was the star in the win over D'Youville with two goals on five shots and an assist.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel picked up its first victory of the season Sunday, defeating Bethany 1-0 ... The Tomcats fell to Penn State-Behrend 3-0 earlier in the week ... Junior Katie Mound scored in the 74th minute of action on a double assist from junior Erica Gregoire and sophomore Kandiance Gibson ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore posted an impressive 11-save shutout for the Tomcats ... Bethany held a 15-7 shot advantage while maintaining a commanding 8-2 edge in corner kicks, but defensively the Tomcats were able to hold them off ... Dunsmore had 14 saves in the Tomcats' 3-0 loss to Penn State Behrend on Tuesday.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans posted a 3-1 road non-conference victory at Penn State-Behrend in their only action of the week on Saturday ... The Lions jumped out to an early 1-0 lead after a goal in the 10th minute, only to see Westminster respond with three unanswered goals ... The Lady Titans knotted the score at 1-1 in the 19th minute, as senior MF Alyssa Pyle scored off an assist by freshman MF Courtney Thompson ... Westminster took the lead just a minute after halftime, as junior MF Melissa Schroder found the back of the net off another Thompson assist ... The final score came in the 78th minute, as junior F Angie DePascale tallied a goal off an assist by Pyle ... Westminster junior GK Nicole Drummond went the distance in goal, making six saves in the victory.
