### *Bethany Bison*

Bethany went 0-2 last week, suffering a 6-1 loss at Geneva and 1-0 heartbreaker against Frostburg ... Junior **Erica Jackson** scored the Bison's only goal in the Geneva loss ... Against Frostburg, a own goal in the 29<sup>th</sup> minute provided the only scoring as Bethany dropped their second in a row ... Bethany was outshot 23-4 against the Bobcats but 10 saves from **Maggie Kuhn** kept the Green and White in the game.

### *Wash. & Jeff. Presidents*

Washington & Jefferson has now dropped four consecutive games after starting the season with a 4-0 shutout of Penn State-Altoona ... The Presidents fell at LaRoche, 3-1, on Tuesday ... The game was a scoreless tie at halftime, but the Redhawks used to quick goals in the second half to jump out to a 2-0 lead and never looked back ... Freshman **Jen Pergola** scored her fifth goal of the year in the loss ... Sophomore goalie **Gretchen Weber** posted eight saves ... W&J was outshot by a 28-6 margin in the loss to CMU, however, the Presidents only trailed, 1-0, at halftime ... Weber was once again solid in the net by corralling 14 saves.

### *Grove City Wolverines*

The Lady Wolverines are looking to reverse a three-match slide that includes last week's two one-goal losses ...
