Bearcat Kylie Simonini had three goals on the week to move into second place on the SVC career points list ... Waynesburg also went 2-0, outscoring its opponents 8-1 last week ... PAC women's soccer teams posted a 9-6 record (.600) against non-conference competition last week.

NEWS & NOTES: W&J junior midfielder Spencer Ahrenholtz scored both President goals, including the game-winner in the 108th minute, of a 2-1 overtime victory at Muskingum ...
