Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped a pair of matches last week to fall to 0-6 ... Wednesday, the Bison fell 4-0 to visiting Pitt-Bradford ... The Panthers built up a 3-0 halftime lead, but Bethany outshot UP-B 8-6 in the second half ... BC just missed putting a goal on the board when **Jen Burin's** shot off a free kick banged off the crossbar in the 88th minute ... In Saturday's tilt at Penn State-Altoona, the Bison outshot the Lions 6-3 in the first half but could not finish and the game was scoreless at intermission ... The final 45 minutes saw Altoona post a 12-1 advantage in shots, but it wasn't until late they finally pushed a shot past sophomore GK **Courtney Teets** with 5:55 to go in the match ... Teets made seven saves in her first start of the season, while the BC offense was led by **Rachelle Smith** and **Kortni Collins** with two shots each.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened a seven-match road trip Saturday afternoon with a come-from-behind 3-2 overtime win at La Roche ... Sophomore **Stephanie Wild** scored an unassisted goal at 81:07 to tie the match 2-2, then scored the game-winner in the 95th minute ... Wild scored the game-winner after a free kick from freshman **Elise Bender** ... Bender scored her first collegiate goal at 39:00, tying the match 1-1 ... Senior **Maia Siber** assisted Bender ... **Diana Prugel** stopped eight shots in goal to earn her fifth win ... Grove City is now 6-0-8 in its last 14 overtime matches ... The Wolverines last lost in overtime Sept. 15, 2001 to John Carroll ... At 5-2, Grove City is off to its best start since 2000, when the Wolverines opened 6-2.
