Bethany dropped a home game to Notre Dame College (Ohio) on Wednesday by a score of 8-1 ... Bethany's goal came from junior **Pennie Thomas** in the 42nd minute ... Bethany freshman goalie **Jessica Alloggia** stopped 10 shots and has now recorded double-digit saves in three consecutive games ... Bethany was outshot in the game 23-8 ... Later in the week, the Bethany Women's Soccer Tournament was canceled due to flooding in the Bethany area ... The Bison were scheduled to face Daemon College and Hiram College.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents opened their 2004 PAC slate with a 2-0 loss at Westminster Wednesday ... Trailing 1-0, the Presidents had a chance to tie the contest on a penalty kick, but the shot attempt sailed wide ... Westminster added an insurance goal with 16 minutes remaining in the contest ... Sophomore MF Rachel Moses scored one goal and assisted on another as W&J blanked Pitt-Greensburg, 3-0, on Saturday ... Moses set up the Presidents' first goal as she fed junior F Toni Lynn Simonini three minutes into the contest ... W&J took a 2-0 lead in the 12th minute as Moses scored off an assist from sophomore F Micala Priola ... Freshman defender Kallen Frey closed the scoring with just over six minutes remaining on an unassisted tally.

Grove City snapped a three-match losing streak by going undefeated last week ... Grove City rallied from a 2-0 deficit to tie Behrend Wednesday as freshman Bethany Peck and junior Katie Klingensmith each scored first-half goals ... Peck picked up the game-winning goal at John Carroll Saturday, her third goal of the season ... Sophomore goalkeeper Kori Koper earned the shutout Saturday, blanking the Blue Streaks for 102 minutes ... Three of Grove City's next four matches are away from home, including conference matches against Washington and Jefferson and Westminster during the final week of the month.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg offense was busy this week, netting a combined 13 goals in two Yellow Jacket victories ... Senior MF Jackie Sassaman led the way for the Jackets, posting nine points during the week ... She connected on a goal in each game, in addition to assisting five others ... She set a career-high with three assists against Ohio Valley in an 8-0 shutout ... Morgan Smoke led the scoring for the Jackets, netting two goals in the victory, while four Jackets contributed goals ... Goalies Emily Byers and Amy Mills split the shutout after facing only three shots ... The Jackets held on to a 5-3 victory over Pitt-Bradford Saturday ... Sophomore Kate Zimmerman recorded two goals, while Sassaman contributed with a goal and another assist.

Against the Presidents, freshman MF Kaitlyn Etzel-Hardman and sophomore F Christa Andamasaris each posted goals, with senior Angie DePascale assisting the first goal ... Senior GK Nicole Drummond earned a pair of shutouts, going the distance with five saves vs. W&J before making eight saves in 80 minutes at Oberlin.
