Grove City Wolverines

Grove City snapped a three-match skid by downing Mount Union at College Field Saturday ... Senior defender Jessica Smith and freshman Megan Guy each scored their first collegiate goal in the win while senior Diane Metzger also scored while Smith and senior Meg Tilley added assists ... Tilley supplied Grove City's offense against Allegheny with an unassisted goal ... Sophomore Lindsay Thompson blanked Mount Union in the first half while frosh Kori Koper stopped four shots in the second half ... Grove City hosts Frostburg State Wednesday in a matchup of 2002 NCAA Tournament gualifiers ... The teams played to a 3-3 draw at Frostburg last year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg doubled its 2002 win total when the Yellow Jackets defeated Pitt-Bradford, 1-0, at home Saturday for their fourth win of the season, improving to 4-4 on the season ... Senior midfielder Janette Schuessler found the back of the net with a first-half unassisted goal ... Lindsay Acker recorded one save, while the Jackets held a 13-0 advantage in corner kicks, and 44-1 in shots ...
