JACKET ATTACK: After opening the 2011 season with a 3-0 loss to Mount Union, the Waynesburg women's soccer team has since ripped out eight consecutive wins ... The Yellow Jackets posted a 3-0 week against non-conference opponents last week, outscoring their foes by a combined 20-1 margin in the three wins ... Senior F **Courtney Ebersole**, the reigning PAC Offensive Player of the Week, tallied six more goals for the Yellow Jackets in the victories last week.

NEWS & NOTES: PAC play gets underway this weekend with five league contests, with defending league champion Washington & Jefferson opening at Geneva ... W&J was a perfect 3-0 last week, including the program's first-ever win over Carnegie Mellon ... Westminster sophomore M **Maura Miglioretti** gave the Titans their first win of the season when she tallied the lone goal in a 1-0 blanking of La Roche ... Bethany went 2-0 on the week, as **Kristen Cottrill** and **Breane Minardi** each scored their first career goals.

Senior GK **Kirstie Mills** earned the shutout in both matches, bringing her career total to 13 ... She has not allowed a goal since the first-half against PS-Altoona on Sept. 17.
