PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week

Mound earned PAC Player of the Week laurels for the second consecutive week after posting a hat trick to account for all three goals for the Tomcats in their 3-2 non-conference win over Baldwin-Wallace. Thiel has now won four straight contests after an 0-6 start. Mound, who netted the game-winning goal against B-W with nine minutes to play in regulation, leads the Tomcats in goals (eight) and points (20).

Also nominated was senior D Lisa Claus of Bethany, senior F Meg Tilley of Grove City, sophomore F Jen Pergola of Washington & Jefferson, and senior MF Alyssa Pyle of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany fell to 0-6 on the year with a loss at Westminster ... Although BC did not manage a shot, their defensive game plan frustrated the defending PAC champions ... The Titan goals both came in the first half, with one coming on a PK ... Bethany trailed Frostburg 2-0 at halftime when a thunderstorm delayed the game ... After waiting for a short period, the game was called because or more expected bad weather ... No make-up has been announced as of yet.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Sophomore forward Jen Pergola scored two goals to lead the Presidents past Marietta, 2-1, on Tuesday evening at Cameron Stadium ... Pergola scored her first goal from 25 yards out in the 18th minute and then redirected home a cross from freshman forward Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli just over three minutes later ... Junior goalie Gretchen Weber made three second-half saves to preserve the win ... The Titans outshot the Presidents, 17-15, on Saturday and scored all three goals in the second half ... Weber kept W&J alive most of the contest with 14 saves ... Pergola has now scored 25 goals in 30 career games.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City knocked off fellow 2002 NCAA Tournament qualifier Frostburg State Wednesday afternoon, bringing Grove City back to the .500 mark ... Four different Lady Wolverines scored goals in the win ... Stacey Brubaker, Kate Klingensmith, Leah Partridge and Meg Tilley all scored while Michelle Novosel had a pair of assists for Grove City ... Sophomore Lindsay Thompson recorded the victory in goal for the Lady Wolverines ... Grove City, which has won two of the last three PAC titles, visits Thiel Wednesday afternoon in the Lady Wolverines' conference opener ... Head coach Melissa Lamie currently has 99 career victories.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In its first tie of the season, Waynesburg couldn't find the back of the net despite holding a shot advantage over Mt. Aloysius in Saturday's non-conference action ... Both teams played to a 0-0 draw after double overtime ... Jackie Sassaman and Morgan Smoke accounted for 15 of Waynesburg's shots, as the Jackets outshot the Mounties, 25-11 ... Sassaman led the team with nine while Smoke had six ... Lindsay Acker made eight stops in net while facing 11 shots (eight on goal) ... Waynesburg (4-4-1) opens PAC play Wednesday at home against Washington & Jefferson for a 4:30 p.m. start

Thiel Tomcats

After dropping its first six games, the Thiel women's soccer team ran their win streak to four last week, the most consecutive games won since the program's inception in 1996 ... Thiel improved to 1-1-1 against Baldwin-Wallace in their all-time series after posting a 3-2 win over the Yellow Jackets Thursday afternoon at Alumni Stadium ... Junior Katie Mound recorded her second straight hat trick in the non-conference win ... Mound currently leads the Tomcats with eight goals and 20 points ... Mound netted the game-winner with just over nine minutes to play ... Junior Laura Simonetti recorded her team-best sixth and seventh assists in Thursday's win ... The Tomcats will take on a pair of PAC foes this week, hosting Grove City on Wednesday and Westminster on Sunday.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans went 2-1 last week, sandwiching home PAC wins against Bethany (2-0) and W&J (3-0) around a 2-0 non-conference loss at regionally-ranked Wooster ... Both goals against the Bison came in the first half ... Against Bethany, senior MF Alyssa Pyle opened the scoring with an unassisted penalty kick goal, then senior MF Michelle Chovan scored her first goal of the season off a Pyle assist ... The Lady Titans broke open a scoreless halftime game with three second half goals vs. W&J ... Junior MF Jen Raub scored twice against W&J, the first assisted by freshman MF Courtney Thompson and the second unassisted ... Freshman F Christa Andamasaris finished the scoring with a goal assisted by Pyle ... Junior GK Nicole Drummond now has four shutouts after blanking Bethany and W&J.
