Griffin did not allow a goal in three consecutive PAC shutout wins for the Lady Titans last week, as Westminster defeated Thiel (6-0), Grove City (1-0) and W&J). Griffin played all 270 minutes in goal, making a combined 18 saves in the three victories. She now has six shutouts in 11 contests this season.

Bethany split a pair of PAC matchups last week and stands 1-1-1 in the league ... The week started with a 4-2 loss at W&J ... Sophomore **Rachelle Smith** scored her first goal of the year in the 13th minute to tie the game, but the Presi-

dents tallied three more scores to take a 4-1 lead at halftime ... Senior **Pennie Thomas** scored her second goal of the season in the second half to make it a two-goal difference ... Saturday at Thiel, the Bison throttled the Tomcats, holding the hosts to zero shots while getting off 18 of their own ... Freshman **Ruthie Pettle** scored her first collegiate goal ... Freshman **Carlyn DiSanti**'s first collegiate goal was sandwiched around two scores by Smith.

Grove City improved to 2-1 in the PAC Friday with a 3-1 win at Waynesburg ... Senior Katie Klingensmith scored twice for Grove City while freshman Laura Shipley added a goal ... Stacey Brubaker and Bethany Peck both
