Grove City posted a 2-0 victory at Bethany, while Westminster scored the game's lone goal late in a 1-0 home decision over Saint Vincent.

Thomas More senior GK **Katie Burger** recorded a combined five saves last week in a pair of TMC shutouts over Mount St. Joseph and Thiel ...
