In a matchup of traditional league powers, two-time defending PAC champion W&J defeated Grove City 3-1 in a rematch of the 2009 PAC title match ... Chatham earned a 3-1 PAC win over Thiel, while Westminster edged Waynesburg 2-1 ... In other league action, Bethany topped Saint Vincent 4-0, while Thomas More rolled past Geneva 6-1.

Sophomore M **Abby Gindling** posted two goals and two assists for six points last week for 2-0 Thomas More ... Freshman M **Elizabeth Lengyel** scored two goals just two minutes apart for Thiel in a 5-0 blanking of Penn St.-Beaver ... Bethany Bison (5-4-1, 1-0 PAC)

Bethany's offense exploded last week in a 7-3 win over Muskingum and 4-0 victory at Saint Vincent to begin PAC play ... **Alaina Heck** scored in the 8th minute and **Cassie Spalding** struck in the 14th minute for the first two goals against Muskingum ... **Julie Lindenfesler** then recorded a natural hat trick with 3 goals in just 2:59 right before halftime to blow the match open ... Spalding scored again and **Kelsey Burnsworth** notched the final goal in the second half ... Geneva Golden Tornadoes (8-1-3)
