Novosel led the Lady Wolverines to PAC wins over Thiel (2-0) and Washington & Jefferson (5-1) last week. She posted her team-best fourth assist of the season against the Tomcats, then tallied a first-half hat trick with three goals before halftime in the victory over W&J.

Also nominated was senior MF Cara Pasquinelli of Bethany, sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore of Thiel, sophomore F Jen Pergola of Washington & Jefferson, and senior D Megan Chovan of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany finally scored their first goal of the season but it wasn't enough for a win as the Bison tied Waynesburg 1-1 ... Senior midfielder Cara Pasquinelli scored BC's first goal off an assist from Jen Burin in the 23rd minute to put the hosts ahead 1-0 ... That lead stood until there was 2:30 remaining in regulation, when the Jackets tied the game with a score ... Neither team was able to win the game in OT, so the game goes down as a tie ... A penalty kick shootout was used just for Conference seeding purposes, which BC won 3-2 ... Burin fired in the tie-breaker in the PK shootout to give Bethany the advantage over Waynesburg.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Sophomore forward Jen Pergola notched her 11th and 12th goals of the season to lead Washington & Jefferson past Waynesburg on Wednesday ... Senior defender Emily Lapkowicz scored her first goal of the season and also assisted on one of Pergola's goals ... Freshman forward Rachel Moses also scored one goal in the win, while classmate Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli dished out two assists ... Freshman goalie Malorie Richmond recorded her first career win after picking up three saves ... Pergola scored her 13th goal of the year in a 5-1 loss at Grove City on Saturday ... Sophomore midfielder Toni Lynn Simonini assisted on the goal.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continues to build momentum into conference play as the Lady Wolverines won a pair of league matches last week ... Junior Michelle Novosel recorded a hat trick against Washington and Jefferson Saturday, scoring three of Grove City's four first-half goals ... Stacey Brubaker assisted on two goals in the match ... Seniors Danielle Balliet and Meg Tilley each scored goals in both matches last week ... The victory over Thiel gave 11th-year head coach Melissa Lamie her 100th career victory ... Eight of Grove City's final 10 matches are including conference meetings, Wednesday's home tilt with defending conference champion Westminster.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After being shutout against W&J on Wednesday, Waynesburg dropped to 0-1-1 in the PAC with a 1-1 tie at Bethany on Saturday ... Bethany took a 1-0 lead early at the 22:30 mark before Janette Schuessler netted the game-tying goal late in the game on an assist from Jackie Sassaman at the 87:30 mark ... The game went to double-overtime with neither team scoring ... Bethany won the shootout, 3-2, to determine seeding in the PAC tournament ... Waynesburg has just one win it its last five games.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women's soccer team lost a pair of home PAC contests last week, falling 2-0 to Grove City on Wednesday and lost a heartbreaking 2-1 overtime game to Westminster on Sunday ... GCC's Danielle Balliet scored in the third minute and Meg Tilley hit in the 71st minute, giving the Lady Wolverines the 2-0 shutout ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore had 15 saves for the Tomcats ... Against Westminster junior Katie Mound tied the game at 1-1 in the 56th minute and the Tomcats held the Lady Titans scoreless over the final 34 minutes to force overtime ... The overtime loss to Westminster was the first time the women's soccer squad had ever forced the Lady Titans to an overtime ... Dunsmore had a career-high 24 saves in the loss.
