PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week

JEN PERGOLA Washington & Jefferson College Freshman forward Monongahela, Pa./Ringgold H.S.

Pergola posted two goals and two assists last week, as W&J moved into a first-place tie in the PAC with conference wins over Thiel (3-2) and Waynesburg (1-0). She had a goal and two assists, including on the gamew-inning goal, in the Thiel win, then scored the game's only goal in the 58th minute against Waynesburg.

Also nominated was junior F **Meg Tilley** of Grove City, sophomore MF **Katie Mound** of Thiel and senior F **Katie Krone** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped their fifth consecutive game and second league contest in a row with a 3-0 loss to Westminster Saturday ... The game was scoreless at halftime before the Titans blew the game open with three second half goals ... Bethany hits the heart of their schedule this week with three games in five days, including two PAC tilts.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J has won three of its last four contests, including two wins last week as it opened PAC play with victories over Thiel and Waynesburg at Cameron Stadium ... Freshman Toni Lynn Simonini broke a 2-2 tie with 33 seconds left in regulation to give the Presidents a 3-2 victory over Thiel ... Freshman Jen Pergola assisted on the game winner and finished the game with one goal and two assists ... Pergola then broke a scoreless tie in the 58th minute in the win over Waynesburg on Friday with an assist going to Simonini ... The Presidents outshot the Yellow Jackets by a 33-3 margin ... Sophomore goalie Gretchen Weber, who ranked 20th in Division III in saves per game heading into last week, amassed nine saves in the two victories.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines remained atop the PAC with a 3-1 triumph over Thiel on Friday ... Karen Reefer gave Grove City a 1-0 lead in the 20th minute while Meg Tilley scored a pair of goals to cement the victory ... Diane Metzger, Danielle Balliet and Jen Bailey all assisted on the goals ... Goalkeeper Katy Turman picked up her 26th career win in goal, making six saves ... The Lady Wolverines have won 18 consecutive PAC matches ... Their last loss came Oct. 29, 1999, a 3-2 setback against Waynesburg in the PAC tournament ... Tilley leads the team with 13 goals and 29 points ... Four of Grove City's next seven matches are at home ... Seven of Grove City's first 10 games were away from home.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg did not score a goal in its two games this week, despite showing improvement on the defense by week's end ... The Jackets were out-shot 26-2 in their 8-0 loss at Westminster on Tuesday, while in their 1-0 loss at Washington & Jefferson on Friday the Jackets were out-shot 22-2 ... **Lindsay Acker** recorded 21 saves to keep the W&J close ... The Jackets host two home PAC games this week versus Bethany (Oct. 9) and Thiel (Oct. 11).

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished 1-2 last week, defeatingPitt-Bradford (2-0) after falling to PAC members W&J (3-2) and Grove City (3-1) ... Senior Jess Peterson and sophomore Katie Mound each scored for TC against W&J, but the Presidents scored the game-winner with 33 seconds left in the game ... Sophomore GK Kristen Benjamin made seven stops in defeat ... In their 3-1 loss to GCC, Peterson tallied the Tomcats only score on an assist from Mound ... Benjamin made 10 saves on 21 GCC shots ... Mound had assists on both sophomore Laura Simonetti's and freshman Ashleigh Dunsmore's goals in the Tomcats 2-0 win at Pitt-Bradford ... Benjamin had three stops in the shutout.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opened PAC play with a pair of shutout wins, topping Waynesburg 8-0 at home on Tuesday and winning at Bethany 3-0 on Saturday ... Three Lady Titans - senior forwards Tammy Newell and Katie Krone and junior forward Alyssa Pyle - led the way offensively with two goals apiece in the Waynesburg win ... Krone added two assists on the afternoon, as did classmate Ashley Tonks and sophomore Katie Fisher ... Posting single goals were senior Krissy Edmonds and sophomore Jen Raub, while sophomore Angie DePascale added a solo assist ... Krone scored twice in the second half against Bethany, then assisted on the final goal by sophomore Nicole Drummond.
