PAC PLAY UNDERWAY: The 2008 PAC league schedule opened this weekend with five contests ... In a battle of traditional league powers on Saturday, defending PAC champion Westminster edged Thomas More 3-2 ... Grove City and W&J joined Westminster atop the standings, as the Wolverines blanked Thiel 7-0 and the Presidents shut out Chatham 3-0 ... Friday, Bethany and Geneva played to a scoreless draw in two overtimes, while Saint Vincent rolled to a 4-0 win over Waynesburg.

WHO'S HOT: W&J posted a pair of 3-0 shutouts last week, topping Franciscan and Chatham ... Leanna Seminsky scored twice for Saint Vincent in a 4-0 blanking of PAC rival Waynesburg ... With a 7-0 win over Thiel, Grove City has now won 10 consecutive PAC openers ... Sophomore GK Lauren Londino stopped seven shots for Geneva in a scoreless draw with Bethany to post her fifth shutout of the season ... For the Bison, GK Julie Brady made five stops for her third shutout this season.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: It was a defensive-oriented week for PAC women's soccer, as at least one team was held scoreless in eight of the 10 contests involving conference teams last week ... Saint Vincent GK Kirstie Mills made 12 saves, including six in two OT sessions, to preserve a 1-1 tie against Baldwin-Wallace Tuesday ... Sophomore F Sarah Nee scored a pair of goals and junior GK Lindsey Mellott faced 22 shots and made nine saves for Westminster in a 3-2 PAC victory at Thomas More.

Bethany Bison (5-4-2, 0-0 PAC)

The Bison women played the first home night game in school history Friday by hosting Geneva at Bison Stadium for Homecoming ... Geneva outshot BC 5-

3 in the opening half, but the Green & White posted a 20-7 advantage in the second half and both OTs, but narrowly missed on several great chances to score the winning goal ... Mills was forced to make just one save for her second career shutout.
