Brubaker posted three goals for six points as she led the Lady Wolverines to PAC wins over Waynesburg (6-0) and Bethany (10-0). She scored once against Bethany and twice vs. Waynesburg. Brubaker also played the final 20 minutes in goal vs. Bethany, making one save to share the shutout victory.

Also nominated was junior F **Jen Pergola** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman F **Scarlett Bretz** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany played three road games last week and went 0-3 ... The Bison have now lost 10 straight games ... The squad started the week with a 5-0 loss at Penn State-Altoona, then traveled to Grove City and lost, 10-0 ... The Bison followed with a non-conference match at Hiram and fell, 2-0 ... The Bison will play its fourth and fifth consecutive road games this week at PAC opponents Waynesburg and Westminster.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson tied Westminster, 3-3, Wednesday at home and then posted a 2-0 victory at Thiel Saturday ... The Presidents trailed the Lady Titans by two goals with 12 minutes remaining, but junior F **Toni Lynn Simonini** scored and junior MF **Rachel Campbell** converted a penalty kick with 90 seconds remaining to force the tie ... Junior F **Jen Pergola** scored one goal and assisted on the other in the Presidents' win at Thiel ... Freshman MF **Elizabeth Monzi** gave W&J the lead for good in the 19th minute ... Sophomore goalie **Marguerite Egan** earned the win after making two saves.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 3-1 in the PAC and moved back over the .500 mark with two lopsided wins last week ... Six different players scored in a 6-0 win over Waynesburg while eight Wolverines scored goals in a 10-0 win over Bethany ... Sophomore **Laura Blosser** scored her first collegiate goal against Waynesburg while classmate **Lindsay Bowman** scored her first goal of the year in the win ... Grove City held a 40-1 shot advantage ... **Kate Klingensmith** had two goals and an assist in the win over Bethany while fellow junior **Stacey Brubaker** scored twice ... Brubaker also played the final 20 minutes of the match in goal, making one save and preserving the shutout.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Waynesburg women's soccer team continues to have trouble finding the net against conference opponents, as well as slowing down opposing offenses ... The Yellow Jackets lost two games this week via shutout to conference foes Grove City, 0-6, and Westminster, 0-4, and now have lost three straight conference games via shutout ... The Jacket offense was outshot this week 58-3 in the two losses and has gone without a goal for approximately 300 minutes ... Sophomore goalie **Emily Byers** made 22 saves in the two games this week ... The Jacket offense has scored only two goals in their last five games, both of which were in the win over Bethany.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped their only contest last week, losing at home to Wash. & Jeff. 2-0 ... The Presidents scored a goal in each half to secure the PAC win ... Junior GK **Ashleigh Dunsmore** recorded a career-high 22 saves in defeat.

Westminster led W&J 3-1 at the half, but the Presidents cut the lead to 3-2 in the 77th minute then scored on a penalty kick with 90 seconds to play ... Senior **Angie DePascale** and freshmen **Brittany McKee** and **Scarlett Bretz** each scored against W&J, while Sarah Calderone had an assist ... Against the Yellow Jackets, frosh **Andrea Michalenko** had a goal and an assist, while Bretz, senior **Katie Fisher** and freshman **Mallory Bugel** also scored ... **Nicole Drummond** posted her school-record ninth shutout of the season with one save, breaking the mark of eight set by **Sarah Morrison** in 2000.
