Defending PAC champion W&J is also unbeaten in PAC play at 3-0, after posting conference wins over Bethany (1-0 in OT) and Waynesburg (2-1) last week ... The two PAC unbeatens are scheduled to face off in Kentucky on Oct. 23.

The Bison suffered losses last week on the road to the last two teams unbeaten in PAC play ... Bethany and W&J played a back-and-forth affair that carried




