PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week

Tilley led Grove City to first place in the PAC via a pair of league wins last week. She scored both goals as the Lady Wolverines topped Westminster 2-1 in a battle of PAC unbeaten, she added a goal and an assist in a 6-0 blanking of Waynesburg. Tilley leads GCC with 10 goals and 23 points this season.

Also nominated was sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore of Thiel, senior D Emily Lapkowicz of Washington & Jefferson, and senior MF Alyssa Pyle of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The struggles continued for the Green and White with three more losses last week ... The Bison battled W&J to a scoreless game through 83 minutes, but the Presidents scored with 6:38 remaining to send Bethany home with a 1-0 loss ... GK Maggie Kuhn stopped six President shots in the setback... Against Behrend, BC trailed by just a goal at intermission but the Lions scored three times in the second half to put the game away ... In the La Roche contest, the Bison were victim to a marvelous performance from Redhawks forward Lindsay Talbot, who scored four goals, including the first three of the game as the visitors built up a 4-0 halftime lead.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior defender Emily Lapkowicz recorded her second goal of the season to lift Washington & Jefferson to a 1-0 victory over Bethany on Wednesday at Cameron Stadium ... Lapkowicz took a loose ball outside of the box with just over six minutes remaining to give W&J the 1-0 advantage ... Freshman Marguerite Egan notched her first career win and shutout in goal ... Despite getting just one goal, Washington & Jefferson dominated the contest, outshooting the Bison by an 18-2 margin and holding a 6-0 advantage in corner kicks ... W&J closes the regular season with four of its last six league matches at Cameron Stadium.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City ran its win streak to six last week with two conference wins ... Senior Meg Tilley scored both goals in the victory over Westminster, the Lady Wolverines' first win over Westminster since 2001 ... Tilley also scored once against Waynesburg while fellow forward Michelle Novosel scored a pair of goals in the win ... Grove City scored four goals in a seven-minute span during the second half to break the match open ... Senior Susannah Cafardi scored her first career goal to cap the spurt while junior Leah Partridge and sophomore Kristin Hummel scored in the first half to give Grove City a 2-0 lead at the break ... The win streak is Grove City's longest since an eight-game streak in 2001 ... Grove City also had a seven-match unbeaten string last year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg suffered two shutouts last week to Thiel and Grove City at home, as it continues to struggle since entering conference play ... The Jackets are winless in their last five and have not won in PAC play ... Their last win was on Sept. 20 against Pitt-Bradford ... Thiel managed only one goal against the Jackets on Wednesday, but it proved enough for the win, 1-0 ... In the game, Morgan Smoke led the Waynesburg with four shots and goalie Lindsay Acker made 12 saves on 14 shots ... Grove City mounted 33 shots on the Jackets on Saturday in a 6-0 win ... The Jackets had just three shots, each by a different player.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel won their only match last week, earning a 1-0 shutout victory over Waynesburg on Wednesday ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore recorded two saves in the PAC win and posted her third shutout of the season ... Junior MF Katie Mound tallied her team-best 10th goal of the season, while junior MF Laura Simonetti served up her team and career-high ninth assist of the season ... Dunsmore was ranked 20th in the latest (Sept. 28) Division III statistics with 11.20 saves per game, but has pushed that number to 11.80 since the last reporting date ... Mound finished with 12 goals all of last season ... Mound and Simonetti are currently tied as the program's all-time leader in goals (22).

Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of games last week, dropping a 2-1 decision to Grove City in a battle of PAC unbeaten before rallying to post a 1-0 non-conference win at Kenyon ... Westminster opened the scoring just 4:21 into the Grove City game, as senior MF Alyssa Pyle scored off assists by senior D Megan Chovan and freshman F Sarah Calderone for an early 1-0 advantage ... However, Grove City got a pair of goals by Meg Tilley to take over first place in the PAC ... Junior GK Nicole Drummond made seven saves in the loss ... At Kenyon, Westminster scored the game's only goal at the 49:36 mark as Pyle scored off assists by Calderone and freshman MF Courtney Thompson ... Drummond made six saves to post her fifth shutout of the season.
