PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week

ALYSSA PYLE Westminster College

Junior forward Sewickley, Pa./Quaker Valley H.S.

Pyle led Westminster into sole possession of first place in the PAC by leading the Lady Titans to PAC shutouts over Thiel (6-0) and Grove City (1-0), breaking the Lady Wolverine' 19-game PAC winning streak in the latter game. She recorded assists on each of the first three goals against the Tomcats, then scored the only goal of the GCC game in the 65th minute.

Also nominated was junior F **Erica Jackson** of Bethany, senior MF **Karen Reefer** of Grove City, and freshman F **Toni Lynn Simonini** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

The Bison snapped a five game losing streak with a double OT win over Waynesburg before dropping games to W&J and Penn State Behrend ... Forward Erica Jackson scored the game-winner early in the second overtime in the Waynesburg victory as Bethany snapped their five-game skid ... Keeper Maggie Kuhn stopped eight shots for her third shutout of the season ... Against W&J, Cara Pasquinelli and Missy Gibson scored goals but Bethany could not overcome an early 2-0 deficit in falling by a goal.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson split a pair of PAC contests this past week, falling to Grove City (9-2), before bouncing back with a 3-2 win at Bethany on Thursday ... Freshmen forwards Jen Pergola and Sandy Simoneaux tallied scores for the Presidents in the loss to the Wolverines ... Junior midfielder Emily Lapkowicz and freshman forward Toni Lynn Simonini gave the Presidents a 2-0 lead at Bethany in the first half and senior forward Quinn Mangis added a late insurance goal as W&J hung on to defeat Bethany, 3-2 ... Sophomore goalie Gretchen Weber, who is averaging 9.9 saves per game, amassed eight saves for the Presidents, who outshot BC, 18-14.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's 19-game PAC win streak came to an end with a 1-0 loss at Westminster in New Wilmington Saturday ... Grove City scored a season-high nine goals against Washington and Jefferson Tuesday at College Field ... Karen Reefer, Kate Klingensmith and Michelle Novosel all scored twice for the Lady Wolverines ... Jen Bailey also scored her first goal of the year in the victory ... The victory was Grove City's fifth straight over Washington and Jefferson ... Of Grove City's five setbacks, three have been shutouts, including Saturday's defeat at Westminster ... The 1-0 loss snapped a five-game unbeaten streak ... Katy Turman stopped 12 shots for GCC.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg had a longer week than expected, as the Yellow Jackets went to double overtime in each of their games to finish the week with an 0-1-1 record ... Bethany outshot Waynesburg 29-9 on Wednesday before solving a scoreless game in double overtime on a goal by Erica Jackson ... Lindsay Acker recorded 25 saves for Waynesburg in net ... On Friday, Thiel and Waynesburg exchanged first-half goals before resulting in a 1-1 tie ... Alicia Lotti netted the Jackets lone goal on a Laura Stopka assist ... Acker stopped 19 shots on goal for Waynesburg.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel finished 0-1-1 last week against two PAC opponents ... Thiel was outshot 50-2 in their 6-0 loss to Westminster ... Sophomore GK **Kristen Benjamin** made 13 stops for the Tomcats against the Lady Titans ... Thiel and Waynesburg battled through two overtime periods Friday to no avail, tying 1-1 after the extra periods ... Sophomore MF **Katie Mound** notched Thiel's only goal, giving her seven on the season ... Mound's 19 points this season (7 G, 5 A) leads the Tomcats in scoring.
