Bethany Bison

The Bison split a pair of PAC contests last week, scoring a 1-0 win over Chatham and dropping a 6-0 decision at Westminster ... In the win over Chatham, the lone goal was an unassisted score by junior **Rachael Katsur** in the 22nd minute ... Bethany's defense took care of the rest, allowing just four shots in the match, including only one in the second half ... Senior **Jess Alloggia** made one save for her third shutout of the season and sixth of her career ... After playing Saint Vincent Wednesday, BC will host W&J Saturday in an important match for the Green & White's PAC Tournament hopes.



Chatham Cougars

Chatham dropped two PAC contests last week ... The Cougars lost a tight 1-0 game at Bethany ... GK **Kristin Podboy** made six saves in the loss ... Chatham got a huge offensive performance by sophomore **Chrissy Fiori** who scored three goals against Grove City College ... Fiori's offense wasn't enough for the win and Chatham dropped the contest by a 10-3 score.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Geneva was unable to put an end to its current winless streak with a pair of losses last week ... Geneva has now gone nine matches without a victory ... On Friday, Geneva got a goal from **Jamie Gessner** against Waynesburg for the team's first lead in six matches ... However, the Yellow Jackets rallied for a pair of second half goals to escape with a 2-1 victory.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split a pair of PAC matches last week and fell from the ranks of the unbeaten ... Thomas More handed the Wolverines a 4-0 setback Tuesday ... However, GCC rebounded with a 10-3 win at Chatham Saturday ... **Emily Ostlund** and **Stephanie Wild** both earned hat tricks against Chatham, while sophomore **Lauren Woodring** added two goals and an assist ... **Anne Koller** and **Esther Harclerode** both added goals for GCC, which led 5-2 at the half ... It is Grove City's first 10-goal outing since Oct. 26, 2004, when the Wolverines beat Bethany, 10-1 ... The 13 combined goals are the most ever in a Grove City women's soccer match.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats went 2-0 last week with wins over Geneva and Thomas More ... In Wednesday's 3-0 win over Geneva, SVC got two goals from **Kylie Simonini** and one from **Adrienne Groth**, all in the first 25 minutes ... The Bearcat defense made the score hold up, holding Geneva to just four shots on goal, all stopped by GK **Jessica Urban** ... Groth, Simonini, and **Ashley Bartko** each recorded assists ... Sunday, SVC snapped Thomas More's nine-game win streak with a 2-1 win ... Groth scored twice in the first 25 minutes, with **Erin Mannella** and **Shelly Teems** getting assists ... Urban made 12 saves in the game, including a penalty kick stop.



Thiel Tomcats

The women's soccer team dropped a pair of PAC road contests last week, losing at Waynesburg 6-0 on Tuesday and at W&J 7-0 on Saturday ... Freshman GK **Jill Harry** registered 12 saves against Waynesburg and 16 saves against W&J.



Thomas More Saints

Sophomore **Brittany Yeggy** set a new single-season goal mark with two goals in the Saints' 4-0 win over Grove City, as the Saints knocked the Wolverines from the ranks of the unbeaten ... Freshmen **Toria Cross** and **Brandi Carmichael** scored the only other goals in the win over GCC ... Freshman **Krystol Miller** scored the only Thomas More goal in the 2-1 loss to Saint Vincent on Sunday.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson suffered a pair of shutout losses during the week, but bounced back with a seven-goal outburst against Thiel on Saturday at Alexandre Stadium ... Junior **Madison Manius** collected a hat trick during the win over the Tomcats, while seniors **Marie Majkut** and **Laura Tomasevich** and sophomores **Karly Hresko** and **Spencer Ahrenholtz** all added one goal ... Tomasevich also finished with two assists ... The Presidents used a 38-0 shot advantage and attempted 16 corner kicks.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets surpassed last season's win total with PAC victories over Thiel, 6-0, and Geneva, 2-1 ... In the shutout victory over the Tomcats, five different WU players scored with sophomore **Katie Gaspich** tallying two goals ... Senior GK **Amy Mills** registered her first complete-game shutout, as she made two saves in 90 minutes of action ... The Yellow Jackets trailed the Golden Tornadoes 1-0 after the first period before **Juli Amato** scored the game-tying goal in the 49th minute ... Amato then assisted on the game-winning goal by **Brittney Brown** ... Mills made nine saves in 90 minutes to earn her fourth win of the season.



Westminster Titans

Westminster had its streak of five straight shutouts snapped Saturday, losing to Mount St. Joseph, 1-0, in non-conference action ... Earlier in the week, the Titans blanked W&J, 3-0, on the road Wednesday and Bethany, 6-0, at home Friday ... WC has shut out 10 teams this season, including nine for wins ... At W&J, junior M **Christina Adams** and sophomore F **Lauren Graeser** each had a goal and two assists, with each assisting on a **Sarah Nee** goal ... Sophomore GK **Lindsey Mellott** made eight saves in her fifth shutout of the season ... Mellott also had 12 saves in the loss to Mount St. Joe's.
