Novosel led the Lady Wolverines to a 2-0 week with PAC wins over Thiel (4-0) and W&J (2-0). She posted three goals for six points in the two league wins, scoring twice against the Tomcats and once versus the Presidents.

Also nominated was freshman MF **Elizabeth Monzi** of Washington & Jefferson, senior midfielder **Jackie Sassaman** of Waynesburg, and senior GK/F **Nicole Drummond** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 0-2 last week, falling to PAC foes Waynesburg (5-0) and Westmisnter (8-0) ... Goalie **Jessica Alloggia** made a career-high 25 saves against the Titans, surpassing her previous career-high of 16, which she accomplished twice earlier this season ... The Bison will play on the road twice this week, at W&J on Wednesday at 5 p.m., then at Thiel on Friday at 4 p.m.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Freshman MF Elizabeth Monzi scored two second-half goals in W&J's 3-1 victory at Waynesburg Tuesday ... After a scoreless first half, Monzi took a pass from junior F Jen Pergola with 23 minutes left in regulation and gave the Presidents a 1-0 lead with her third goal of the season ... Junior MF Toni Lynn Simonini booted her ninth goal of the year 68 seconds later for a 2-0 W&J advantage ... The Yellow Jackets (4-8, 1-4 PAC) sliced the lead in half with just over 17 minutes remaining, but Monzi then put the game away for W&J with a goal at the 6:07 mark off an assist from Simonini ... Senior GK Gretchen Weber collected five saves to earn the win ... Sophomore GK Marguerite Egan made three saves in the Grove City loss.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines extended their win streak to four last week with a pair of conference victories ... Senior Michelle Novosel scored twice in a 4-0 victory at Thiel last Wednesday afternoon while Katie Klingensmith had a goal and an assist in the Wolverines' 2-0 win over Washington and Jefferson Friday ... Novosel also scored in Friday's win ... Klingensmith leads Grove City with six assists ... The Wolverines have recorded four straight shutouts and have not allowed a goal in 368 minutes ... Grove City is wrapping up a stretch in which four of their five matches have been at home ... Grove City will earn home-field advantage in the PAC Tournament by winning their final four matches.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg surpassed its win total from each of the past two seasons ... The Yellow Jackets won their second conference game of the season with a 5-0 victory over Bethany after not winning a conference game the last two seasons ... Jackie Sasssaman recorded a team-high five points in the win over the Bison with two goals and an assist, marking the fifth time this season the senior recorded both a goal and an assist ... Sassaman leads the Jackets with 29 points on nine goals and 11 assists this season ... Sassaman ended the Jackets' 300-minute scoreless drought in the loss to W&J earlier in the week ... Joining Sassaman in recording multiple goals against the Bison was sophomore Morgan Smoke.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat women's soccer team went 0-2-1 last week ... Thiel fell in PAC action to Grove City on Wednesday 4-0 before heading for the OBX Classic in Nags Head, N.C. over the weekend ... The Tomcats were defeated in the opening game 6-0 by Salisbury University (Md.) on Saturday before battling host Chowan to a 0-0 double overtime tie ... Junior GK **Ashleigh Dunsmore** posted 12 saves against Salisbury before turning in 10 save performance against Chowan ... The shutout against Chowan was Dunsmore's fifth of the season.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titans split a pair of matches last week, falling to Wooster (#6 in Great Lakes Region) 5-1 before remaining in first place in the PAC with an 8-0 shutout of Bethany ... Freshman Brittany McKee scored the lone goal in the loss to the Scots, assisted by classmate Anna Sparacino ... Against the Bison, the team's starting GK, Nicole Drummond, instead started at forward and recorded a hat trick with three goals ... Other players recording goals included McKee, Sparacino, senior Melissa Schroder and freshmen Scarlett Bretz and Shannon Ecklund ... Senior GK Laura Vollmer earned the shutout in her first start of the season, as she made four saves ... Westminster outshot Bethany 37-4.
