PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER 2011 - Week 7 Conference Notes

W&J-TMC HEADED FOR CLASH: With just two weeks remaining in the 2011 PAC women's soccer regular season, defending PAC champion Washington & Jefferson and Thomas More each posted a pair of conference wins last week to remain tied at the top of the league standings ... The two league powers appear headed for a clash to determine the top seed for the 2011 PAC Tournament at Washington & Jefferson on Wednesday, October 26th at 7 p.m.

NEWS & NOTES: Thiel posted its first PAC women's soccer victory since the 2004 season when the Tomcats edged Chatham 2-1 in overtime on a game-winning goal by sophomore **Taryn Benner** ... Thomas More has won six straight matches, as senior GK **Katie Burger** made five saves for the 2-0 Saints last week ... Senior F **Emily Hurley** scored two second half goals for Grove City in the Wolverines' 5-0 PAC blanking at Thiel ... Junior F **Julie Lindenfeser** scored the lone goal for Bethany in a 1-0 win at Geneva.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Washington & Jefferson is ranked 10th in the most recent NSCAA Great Lakes Region poll ... Waynesburg secured its first-ever win over Westminster 1-0 on a goal by **Becky Hotek** ... Sophomore F **Jennifer Kisner** scored the game-winning goal for Saint Vincent in a 2-1 win at Bethany ... Senior D **Kelli Michanowicz** scored the lone goal for Westminster in a 4-1 PAC loss to Thomas More ... First-year **Sarah Ellis** scored the lone goal for Chatham in a 2-1 PAC OT loss at Thiel.

Bethany Bison (7-6, 3-2 PAC)



The Bison went 1-1 last week and now stand at 3-2 in the PAC ... Bethany and Geneva played an even match Wednesday in Beaver Falls, as the BC held a narrow 11-9 margin in shots ... The difference in the match was an unassisted goal by **Julie Lindenfelsler** with just 44 seconds left in the first half ... **Brittany Sadler** made two saves in the shutout ... Bethany grabbed an early 1-0 lead against Saint Vincent Saturday when **Paige Prato** scored off an assist from **Cassie Spalding** just 2:19 into the match ... The Bearcats tied the game in the 36th minute and scored the game-winning goal in the 76th minute, as SVC came back for a 2-1 win ... Bethany suffered the setback despite a 14-7 advantage in shots.

Chatham Cougars (1-10, 0-5 PAC)



The Cougars showed a strong performance against Thiel College on Saturday, losing four minutes into overtime ... Shots on goal came from junior **Eiise Zavadak** and first-year **Sarah Ellis** ... GK **Liz Sawyer** had 11 saves in goal.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (4-10-1, 0-5 PAC)



Geneva women's soccer just cannot generate offense these days ... The Golden Tornadoes dropped shut-out decisions to Bethany and Thomas More last week as they saw their losing streak reach five straight including an 0-5 mark against PAC competition ... Geneva has scored just twice in those five matches and has tallied only four goals during a stretch that has seen it drop eight of the last nine matches ... Playing in just her second collegiate action in goal Saturday, **Natalie Swartley** came in to relieve an injured **Karmyn Culbertson** and allowed just one goal and made nine saves against Thomas More. Geneva will host Waynesburg Wednesday in the team's home finale.

Grove City Wolverines (5-6-2, 3-2 PAC)



Grove City 1-1 in PAC action last week, highlighting the week with a 5-0 win at Thiel Tuesday ... **Emily Hurley** scored twice while **Sarah Cessar**, **Sarah Peachey** and **Sam Weber** added goals ... D **Jessica Heck** recorded two assists ... **Kristi Lathrop** earned her first shutout win in goal ... GCC owned a 27-2 edge in shots ... Saturday, Grove City dropped a 2-1 decision to visiting W&J ... D **Lydia Caissy** scored her first goal of the season to draw the Wolverines into a first-half tie ... Grove City outshot the Presidents 12-10 ... Grove City has 199 victories all-time in 20 years of intercollegiate play ... The Wolverines play three times this week, starting with visiting Chatham Tuesday in conference play at 3:30.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-7-1, 2-3 PAC)



After a 1-0 loss to Waynesburg on Wednesday, the Bearcats rebounded to earn a 2-1 victory on the road at Bethany on Saturday night ... Bethany scored two minutes into the game before SVC battled back ... Near the end of the 36th minute, sophomore **Tenesha Corrales** stole a pass and notched her third goal of the season to tie the game, 1-1 ... With under 15 minutes left in the game, sophomore **Jennifer Kisner** scored her first goal of the season off an assist from freshman **Abbey Neish** to put SVC ahead for good.

Thiel Tomcats (5-9-2, 1-4 PAC)



The Tomcats posted a 1-1 record on the week, losing 5-0 to Grove City and defeating Chatham 2-1 in overtime to give the Tomcats their best record and their first PAC win since 2004 ... In the Grove City contest, freshman GK **Claire Frederiks** notched 12 saves for Thiel ... In the second game of the week vs. Chatham, sophomore **Kelsey Adair** scored her first goal of the season to put Thiel up 1-0 ... After the Cougars scored late in the contest to send the game to overtime, sophomore **Taryn Benner** gave Thiel the victory with a goal in the 94th minute to move the Tomcats record to 1-1-2 in overtime games this season (all of which have been played at home).

Thomas More Saints (8-3, 5-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its win streak to a season-high six matches as it defeated Westminster and Geneva last week ... Junior F **Courtney Clark** led the Saints in scoring with six points on three goals, while senior F **Lauren Wietmarschen** had one goal and one assist for three points ... Senior GK **Katie Burger** played all 180 minutes in goal as she recorded five saves and one shutout, while only allowing one goal ... For the season, Clark leads the team in scoring with 20 points on nine goals and two assists, while freshman M **Sam Work** is second with 16 points on seven goals and two assists ... Burger has an 8-3 record in goal and has 29 saves and five shutouts.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (11-3, 5-0 PAC)



W&J set a new school record with nine straight wins after beating Chatham and Grove City this week ... The three-time defending PAC champion Presidents were ranked 10th in last week's NSCAA poll ... Junior **Chrissy Marcus** leads the PAC with 13 assists this season, a new single-season W&J record ... She is again first in the country in assists per game this week ... Six different players tallied goals at Chatham on Wednesday ... Sophomore **Holly Shipley** led the team with two goals and one assist ... Junior **Dawn Murphy** scored both goals at Grove City on Saturday ... Saturday marked Murphy's second multi-goal game of the season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (13-2, 4-1 PAC)



The Waynesburg women's soccer team used a stingy defense and just enough offense to go 2-0 this week and grab hold of third place in the PAC standings ... Freshman **Taylor Bombalski** took a feed from sophomore **Susie Godwin** to score the only goal in the Yellow Jackets' battle with Saint Vincent, and another first-year Jacket, **Becky Hotek**, scored her fourth goal of the year off an assist from sophomore **Taylor Augustine** to beat Westminster for the first time in program history ... Senior GK **Katrina Kelly** totaled 11 saves in the two wins to notch her seventh and eighth shutouts of the season.
