SHOWDOWN SATURDAY: The race for the 2010 PAC Women's Soccer Championship Tournament is underway with two weeks to play, as the league co-leaders get set to battle ... Defending champion W&J improved to 4-0 in the PAC with a 9-0 blanking of Chatham ... Thomas More is also 4-0 in league play following wins over Westminster and Thiel, followed by Grove City at 3-1 vs. the PAC ... The Saints host the Presidents at The Bank of Kentucky Field on Saturday at 1:30 p.m.

NEWS & NOTES: Sophomore M **Grace Rieman** assisted on each of the first three goals for Grove City in the Wolverines' 4-1 PAC win over Bethany Saturday ... Washington & Jefferson junior M **Elizabeth Bendick** scored the lone goal for the Presidents in a 1-0 win over Geneva ... Freshman F **Courtney Clark** scored the first two goals for Thomas More in an 8-0 blanking of Thiel Sunday ... Freshman **Rebecca Sandor** scored with just 42 seconds to play to lift Saint Vincent past Waynesburg 1-0.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **Danielle Struble** scored Westminster's only goal in a 1-0 blanking of Saint Vincent ... **Cassie Spalding** scored the lone goal for Bethany in a 1-0 win over Geneva ... Waynesburg senior D **Sarah Spicuzza** had a goal and an assist in a 6-0 win over Chatham ... Since starting 8-0-3, Geneva has lost three straight and four of its last five matches ... Chatham has dropped four straight matches after an 0-2 week, while Thiel is looking to break a five-match losing streak after going 0-2.

Bethany Bison (6-7-1, 1-3 PAC)



After taking a 1-0 victory over Geneva at home Wednesday night, the Bison dropped a 4-1 decision at Grove City to fall to 1-3 in the PAC ... In the Geneva victory, **Cassie Spalding** scored off an assist from **Loren McAnany** in the 11th minute for the lone goal ... GK **Brittany Sadler** made four saves for her second shutout of the year ... In the Grove City match, the Wolverines scored twice in the first four minutes, but BC trimmed the deficit to 2-1 in the 43rd minute on freshman **Donovan Reed's** first collegiate goal ... Bethany was unable to score again before GCC added two insurance goals in the final 17 minutes ... The Bison have home matches vs. Thiel Wednesday and Waynesburg Saturday.

Chatham Cougars (4-10, 1-4 PAC)



The Cougars were defeated and shut out in both conference matches this week against W&J and Waynesburg ... With these losses, Chatham falls to 1-4 in PAC standings and 4-10 overall for the season.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (9-4-3)



The women's soccer team has fallen on some tough times in recent matches ... The Golden Tornadoes fell to 9-4-3 with a pair of 1-0 shutout losses to Bethany and Washington & Jefferson ... Geneva has dropped three straight and four of five since a perfect 8-0-3 record in the month of September ... Geneva will look to right the ship this week with two more PAC matches against Westminster and Chatham University.

Grove City Wolverines (9-5, 3-1 PAC)



Grove City continued its second-half surge by earning a pair of home wins in PAC play last week ... Wednesday, the Wolverines blanked Thiel 6-0 ... **Sarah Cessar** and **Arielle Goyzueta** each had a goal and an assist in the win ... **Cara Colley**, **Emily Hurley**, **Chelsea Tarolli** and **Sam Weber** all scored ... Grove City owned a 30-2 shot edge ... Saturday, Grove City scored twice in the first 3:19 in a 4-1 win over Bethany ... **Grace Rieman** assisted on both of those goals ... She also assisted **Morgan Osterhouse's** insurance goal in the 74th minute ... **Hannah Yang** and **Michelle Stevens** scored the first two goals respectively and Hurley closed the scoring at 80:12 ... Hurley leads the team with 10 goals.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (4-7-3, 3-2 PAC)



The Bearcats split a pair of home PAC matches on the week, defeating Waynesburg 1-0 on Tuesday before falling by the same score to Westminster on Saturday ... The Waynesburg game was a dramatic one, as freshman **Rebecca Sandor** scored with just 42 seconds left in the second half ... **Kirstie Mills** made 13 saves in goal to record her third straight shutout win ... The loss to Westminster snapped SVC's three-game winning streak, and a first half Titan goal was the first the Bearcats surrendered in 310 minutes ... Westminster owned a 27-12 advantage in shots, with Mills making 11 saves.

Thiel Tomcats (2-13, 0-4 PAC)



Thiel dropped a pair of matches to conference opponents ... The Tomcats were shut out by Grove City 6-0 on Wednesday and were shut out by Thomas More 8-0 on Sunday.

Thomas More Saints (10-0-3, 4-0 PAC)



The Saints remained unbeaten and extended their winning streak to six matches as they won a pair of PAC matches over Westminster and Thiel ... Junior D **Kelsie Rust** led the team in scoring last week with six points on two goals, including the game-winner against Westminster, and two assists ... Freshman F **Courtney Clark** netted two goals in the Saints' win at Thiel ... Junior GK **Katie Burger** earned the two wins as she played 90 minutes in goal and recorded seven saves ... Senior DE **Alex Crouch** helped anchor the defense that posted two shutouts last week and only allowed 11 goals, including none against Thiel, in 180 minutes of action.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (10-4, 4-0 PAC)



W&J posted another undefeated week to push its win streak to seven ... Seven different goal scorers led the Presidents to a 9-0 win over Chatham Wednesday ...
