Bethany dropped two more games last week and have lost five consecutive ... The Bison outshot Thiel 16-8 but only managed one goal in the loss ... **Bethany Mucho**'s goal in 64th minute cut the Lady Cat lead to 2-1, but Thiel answered with the clincher in the 77th minute ... In the Grove City loss, **Kylie Harvey** scored on Bethany's only shot of the game ... The Lady Wolverines outshot Bethany 22-1.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson dropped a pair of conference tilts this past week to Westminster (4-2) and Thiel (2-0) ... The Presidents put up a good fight against conference-leading Westminster despite being outshot by a 29-4 margin ... The Titans broke a 2-2 tie with 14 minutes left and added a goal in the final minute in recording the victory ... Freshman F Jen Pergola put the Presidents ahead 1-0 in the 13th minute and junior MF Emily Lapkowicz tied the game, 2-2, in the 58th minute off a free kick ... Sophomore goalkeeper Gretchen Weber totaled 12 saves in the loss ... Freshman F Toni Lynn Simonini led the Presidents with three shots in the loss at Thiel.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines are 6-1-1 in their last eight games after blitzing two conference opponents last week ... Diane Metzger scored in each match, as did Karen Reefer, Meg Tilley and Michelle Novosel ... Metzger assisted on Tilley and Novosel goals against Waynesburg ... Goalkeepers Katy Turman and Lindsey Thompson combined for the shutout of Waynesburg, which was Grove City's first this year ... Katie Klingensmith had a goal and two assists against Bethany ... Grove City has won 21 of its last 22 conference matches ... The Lady Wolverines are 4-0 at home against conference foes, 5-1 overall at College Field ... Three of Grove City's final four conference games are on the road.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is winless in its last nine games ... The Jackets suffered shutout losses to Grove City (6-0) on Tuesday and to Westminster (4-0) on Friday ... The Wolverines outshot Waynesburg 39-0 ... Waynesburg will host Washington & Jefferson on Wednesday.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats posted their sixth and seventh wins of the season last week, going 2-0 against PAC opponents ... Thiel defeated Bethany on the road Tuesday 3-1 and earned a 2-0 shutout victory at home against W&J on Friday ... The shutout was Thiel's fifth of the season and sophomore GK Kristen Benjamin's fourth, both single-season school records ... Three different players - sophomore MFs Laura Simonietti and Katie Mound, and freshman F Ashleigh Dunsmore scored in their victory over Bethany ... Senior MF Jess Peterson scored her team-leading ninth goal in the win over W&J ... Simonetti and Mound, each with eight goals and five assists, are currently tied for the team lead in points with 21.

Westminster Titans

Westminster continued to roll this week with PAC wins at W&J (4-2) and Waynesburg (4-0), giving WC seven consecutive wins and a 10-1 mark in the team's last 11 games after an 0-4 start

... Seniors Katie Krone and Tammy Newell each scored twice at W&J, as the Lady Titans gave up their first goals of the season in conference play ...
