She then scored her 10th goal of the season in a 3-3 PAC draw with Chatham, becoming the first BC double-digit goal scorer since 2005.

TIGHT AT THE TOP: The PAC standings remain tight at the top with two weeks to play until the PAC Tournament ... W&J battled Westminster through 120 minutes in New Wilmington Friday night, settling for a scoreless draw ... The contest put Westminster in the PAC lead, as W&J fell at Thomas More 1-0 earlier in the week ... TMC is alone in second after shutouts of W&J and Grove City (2-0) ... NCAA D-III provisional member Geneva has just one loss in its last nine matches (4-1-4).

WHO'S HOT: Freshman F **Cassie Spalding** scored three goals for Bethany in a 1-0-1 week, including both scores in a 2-0 PAC win over Waynesburg on Wednesday ... GK **Lauren Londino** of Geneva posted her seventh shutout of the season, stopping seven shots in a scoreless draw with Saint Vincent ... Junior **Kristin Podboy** scored two second half goals to lead Chatham to a 3-3 PAC draw with Bethany Saturday, giving the Cougars their first point in PAC play this season.
