Bethany split a pair of PAC matches last week, dropping a 6-2 decision at W&J before snapping a three-game losing skid with a 1-0 victory over Waynesburg ... The Bison fell behind 4-0 at W&J and never recovered, despite second

half goals from seniors **Katie Mills** and **Jen Burin** ... The score for Mills was her team-leading fifth of the season and came on a PK ... Burin's goal, her third this year, was assisted by sophomore **Rachael Katsur** ... On Saturday, junior **Rachelle Smith** scored with just 1:31 to go before halftime and the BC defense made that goal stand in a 1-0 victory over Waynesburg ... Smith's score came off her own rebound and was her third of the year ... Sophomore **Courtney Teets** stopped four shots in the victory, including three in the first half to keep the Yellow Jackets off the board.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats fell to 1-14-1 with losses to Westminster and Saint Vincent last week ... Freshman GK **Sarah Echenoz** made 48 total saves in the losses ... The Tomcats travel to Grove City on Thursday to take on the Wolverines ... They then close out the season with a home

The Titans held Thiel without a shot as they outshot the Tomcats 43-0 ...
