Thompson posted shutouts in PAC victories over Washington & Jefferson (2-0) and Westminster (1-0) last week, giving Grove City the #1 seed and home field advantage throughout the upcoming PAC Tournament. She posted four saves against W&J and three at Westminster. Thompson has five shutouts on the season and has not given up a goal in the last 191 minutes.

Also nominated was sophomore MF Jennifer Burin of Bethany, junior MF Katie Mound of Thiel, junior MF Carrie Pazehoski of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman F Christa Andamasaris of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison finally got their first win of the season Tuesday with a 1-0 blanking of Waynesburg ... The score was not indicative of the game, as Bethany dominated action in shots (18-3) and corners (12-0) ... The lone goal was scored by Jennifer Burin, her first of the season, in the 25th minute off an assist from Erica Jackson ... GK Maggie Kuhn stopped three shots in the win ... Against W&J, two first half goals were enough as the Presidents picked up their second win of the year over BC 2-0 ... Kuhn made six more saves in the loss for the Green and White.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J has won five of its last seven matches and nearly knocked off first-place Grove City last Tuesday, falling 2-0 ... The game remained scoreless until the 83rd minute when a long GCC shot was able to sneak past W&J junior goalkeeper Gretchen Weber ... Weber totaled six saves in the losing effort for W&J, which was out-shot by a 21-9 margin ... Junior midfielder Carrie Pazehoski and freshman forward Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli scored the Presidents goals ... Pazehoski found the back of the net off an assist from senior defender Emily Lapkowicz 20 minutes in and then Mancinelli-Loffreda scored just over 18 minutes later ... Freshman forward Rachel Moses assisted on the second goal ... Weber made two saves in 67 minutes to earn the win.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City extended its new school record by winning its 11th straight match ... Grove City wrapped up the top seed and home-field advantage in next week's conference tournament with a 1-0 win at Westminster last Thursday ... Freshman Maia Siber scored her first career goal to give Grove City the lead late in the match ... Sophomore Lindsay Thompson had a pair of shutouts in two PAC matches last week, raising her season record to 11-3-1 ... Diane Metzger and Meg Tilley each scored in the final 10 minutes to lift Grove City past W&J last Tuesday afternoon ... Michelle Novosel had an assist, her team-best eighth of the season ... Grove City currently has a 14-match unbeaten streak in PAC regular season play.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is winless in its last nine games and scoreless in its last six games after losing to Bethany (1-0) and at Thiel (2-0) last week ... The Jackets were outshot by Bethany, 7-3, and by Thiel, 11-5 ... Waynesburg hasn't won a regular season PAC game since Oct. 5, 2001, and is 0-19-3 during that stretch.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 in PAC action last week ... The Tomcats were shut out at Westminster 5-0 on Tuesday before earning a 2-0 shutout victory over Waynesburg on Friday ... Westminster tallied four first-half goals in its 5-0 win on Tuesday ... Junior MF Katie Mound scored her 13th and 14th goals of the season in the Tomcats 2-0 shutout of Waynesburg on Friday ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore recorded her fourth shutout of the season in the win ... Freshman F Lindsay Cimino had assists on both Mound goals, giving her five on the season ... Mound set a new single-season record in goals with 14 this season and is also the program's all-time leading scorer with 69 points (29 G, 11 A).

Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-2 last week ... The Lady Titans extended their win streak to four with a 5-0 PAC shutout of Thiel on Tuesday, before falling to PAC leader Grove City (1-0) on Thursday and at non-conference foe Frostburg State (1-0) on Sunday ... Freshman F Christa Andamasaris led the way vs. Thiel with a pair of goals, while juniors Angie DePascale, Stephanie Toth and Nicole Drummond added solo tallies ... Senior MF Alyssa Pyle dished out a pair of assists in the win, while players posting single assists included senior Michelle Chovan, juniors Katie Fisher and Jen Raub and freshman Courtney Thompson ... Drummond and junior Laura Vollmer split the shutout in goal ... Drummond posted nine saves in both the GCC and FSU losses.
