Junior forward Columbia, Md./Hammond H.S.

Tilley led the Lady Wolverines to a 2-0 week with a pair of PAC shutouts over Thiel (1-0) and Washington & Jefferson (5-0). She scored the lone goal on the Thiel game for her fourth game-winning goal of the season, then had a pair of assists against W&J.

Bethany Bison

After getting buried under five second half goals in a 7-0 loss at Westminster, the Bison rebounded with a solid 2-0 shutout over Waynesburg ... Junior **Abby Sacco** scored her first goal of the year in the 15th minute to give Bethany the lead early ... Junior **Cara Pasquinelli** found the back of the net off a cross from senior **Missy Gibson** in the 22nd minute to double the Bison advantage ... It would prove to be all Bethany would need, as keeper **Maggie Kuhn** stopped three shots to record her fourth shutout of the year.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Freshman midfielder Rachel Campbell scored her first two career goals to lift Washington & Jefferson past Waynesburg, 3-0, on Wednesday evening ... Freshman forward Jen Pergola got the Presidents off to a quick start with a goal six minutes into the first half off an assist from freshman forward Toni Lynn Simonini ... Campbell notched her first goal two minutes later and then capped the scoring in the 75th minute as W&J clinched the three-goal win ... Sophomore goalkeeper Gretchen Weber recorded her third shutout of the season after making nine saves ... Weber stopped five shots in the 5-0 loss to Grove City on Friday evening ... Senior forward Quinn Mangis led the Presidents with two shots.

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines are 8-1-1 in their last 10 after two conference victories last week ... Six different players scored Grove City's six goals last week ... Meg **Tilley** scored the game-winner at Thiel last Wednesday and then had two assists in a 5-0 win over Washington and Jefferson Friday night ... Jen Bailey, Stacey Brubaker, Kristin Hummel Michelle Novosel and Karen Reefer all tallied goals against the Presidents ... Katy Turman recorded both wins in goal last week ... Grove City can earn a share of the regular season conference title with wins over Westminster and Waynesburg this week ... Grove City will recognize Bailey, Reefer and Turman on Senior Day this Thursday.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg continues to struggle scoring goals as the Jackets suffered their fourth straight shutout loss with a 2-0 defeat to Bethany on Friday ... Waynesburg has only two goals in its last 11 games and now drops to 0-8-1 in the PAC and 2-13-1 overall ... Bethany limited Waynesburg to six shots ... The Jackets were also shut out by Washington & Jefferson on Wednesday, 3-0.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women's soccer teamed dropped a pair of conference matches last week to Grove City (1-0) and Westminster (4-0) ... Grove City outshot the Tomcats 7-1 in the opening half of action but were held scoreless by senior Jess Peterson and the Tomcat defensive unit ... Freshman Ashleigh Dunsmore, filling in for sophomore Kristen Benjamin in goal, made eight stops against GCC ... Westminster outshot the Tomcats by a 21-7 margin ... Sophomore Katie Mound led Thiel with three shots against the Lady Titans.
