Bethany Bison

Bethany snapped a nine game losing streak with its win over W&J in the first round of the PAC Tournament ... Cara Pasquinelli scored Bethany's goal in regulation and Leondra Thomas, Pasquinelli and Missy Gibson connected on PK's to send the Bison to the semifinals ... Thomas made nine saves in the victory ... In the semifinal, Lisa Claus scored her first goal of the year, while Thomas made 25 saves in the setback.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents lost to Bethany in the first round of the PAC Tournament on Wednesday evening on penalty kicks as Bethany edged W&J by a 3-2 count (on pk's).

Grove City Wolverines

The Lady Wolverines claimed their second straight PAC women's soccer title and fifth overall, tying Bethany for the most league crowns since the first was decided in 1991.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets fell short of their first PAC title since 1998 as the conference's runner-up ... Lisa Juskowich finishes her career with 99 career goals, after scoring 3 goals in as many games on 22 shots ... Freshman Katie Kirk scored the team's lone goal versus LaRoche, while Ryanne Purdum added an insurance goal in the team's win over Thiel.

Thiel Tomcats

The Lady Cats finished their season with a 7-10-4 overall record and a 3-3-2 mark in the PAC ... Freshman Laura Simonetti led the way offensively for the Thiel with a season-record nine goals and 23 points ... Senior captain Amanda Devore was second on the squad with seven goals and 16 points ... Simonetti and fellow freshman Katie Mound were named to the 2001 All-PAC First Team, while Devore and and junior midfielder Jess Peterson were named to the Second Team.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster women's soccer team posted a 2-0 week to finish 15-5 on the season ... The 15 wins tied a program record for wins in a season, originally set by the 1998 Lady Titan soccer team (15-3) ... Senior **Ashley Pyle** posted a career-high four goals and added an assist in the Lady Titans 5-1 win over NCAA D-II Clarion on Sunday ... Pyle finished the season with 25 goals and nine assists for 59 points, extenind her Westminster career records in those categories to 80 goals, 39 assists and 199 points.
