PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER 2011 - Week 9 Conference Notes

POSTSEASON PLAY AT W&J: The 2011 PAC Championship Tournament begins this week, with three-time defending conference champion Washington & Jefferson earning the top seed and home field advantage throughout ... The Presidents host local rival and #4 seed Waynesburg Tuesday at 7 p.m. in one semifinal, while #2 Thomas More hosts #3 Grove City in the other semi at 2 p.m. ... The championship is scheduled for Saturday (Nov. 5) at the highest remaining seed at a time TBA.

NEWS & NOTES: W&J is ranked ninth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Region poll ... Waynesburg is making its first appearance in the PAC Women's Soccer Tournament since 2005 ... Thomas More sophomore M **Kirstie Reilman** scored a pair of goals for the Saints in a 5-0 PAC victory against Waynesburg Saturday ... Sophomore F **Shannon Bishop** scored twice in the final eight minutes to break a 1-1 tie and lift Grove City past Saint Vincent 3-1 ... After a tough season, Geneva closed its 2011 schedule with a 2-0 week.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior F **Shanay Phillian** scored the game-winning goal with 1:36 to play, while freshman D **Nicole Jeschelnig** scored the lone goal for Thiel in a 2-1 PAC loss to Westminster ... Bethany's lone score came on an "own goal" by Waynesburg in a 1-1 draw Wednesday ... **Rebecca Pell** and **Brianna Sharkady** scored goals for Chatham vs. Saint Vincent, while freshman F/M **Abbey Neish** recorded her first career hat trick with three goals for the Bearcats in the PAC win.

Bethany Bison (8-8-1, 4-4-1 PAC)

Bethany was eliminated from PAC Tournament contention after a 0-1-1 week ... An own goal gave BC a 1-0 lead in the 52nd minute at Waynesburg, but the Yellow Jackets tied the match in the 81st minute and the teams settled for a 1-1 draw ... Needing a win over W&J in the season finale, Bethany only trailed 1-0 at halftime, but the Presidents erupted for 4 goals in less than seven minutes to pull away for a 5-0 victory ... The senior class of **Missy Baldwin, Kristen Cottrill, Breane Minardi and Cassie Spalding** led the program to 32 wins during their careers and three consecutive seasons with a .500 or better record.



Chatham Cougars (1-14, 0-9 PAC)

The Cougars ended their season on two home losses ... Chatham lost on Wednesday to Geneva, 4-0 ... GK **Liz Sawyer** made 17 saves in the loss ... Saturday, they fell to Saint Vincent 8-2 ... **Rebecca Pell** scored in the first half on a breakaway ... **Brianna Sharkady** added another goal in the second half off a pass from **Paula Cardona** ... Sawyer again had 17 saves.



Geneva Golden Tornadoes (6-12-1, 2-7 PAC)

It was an offensive struggle for the Geneva women's soccer team for much of the 2011 season ... The Golden Tornadoes, however, were able to put a good taste in their mouths to finish the campaign with back to back 4-0 victories over Chatham and Thiel to close out the season ... Geneva finished the season with a 6-12-1 overall record and a 2-7 mark in the PAC ... **Maura Allen** and **Becca Shaw** each scored a pair of goals in the victory over Chatham while **Shaw, Kathryn Wiater, Rhetta King** and **Justine Miller** each found the net against Thiel ... **Natalie Swartley** ended her career with a pair of shut-outs to her record.



Grove City Wolverines (10-6-2, 7-2 PAC)

Grove City went 2-0 last week in PAC play, sewing up the third seed in this week's conference tournament ... Wednesday, GCC knocked Saint Vincent from tournament contention with a 3-1 win ... **Shannon Bishop** scored twice in the final eight minutes for Grove City ... **Sam Weber** also scored in the win ... Head coach **Melissa Lamie** earned her 200th victory in 19 seasons as head coach ... Saturday night, Grove City clinched the third seed with a 2-0 win at Westminster ... **Weber** and **Arielle Goyzueta** each scored for the Wolverines while **Tiffany Yost** recorded the shutout in goal ... **Weber** and **Grace Rieman** share the team lead with six goals each ... **Rieman** leads the team with four assists and 16 total points.



Saint Vincent Bearcats (8-9-1, 4-5 PAC)

Freshman **Abbey Neish** recorded a hat trick in the Bearcats 8-2 win over Chatham on Saturday as Saint Vincent wrapped up the 2011 season with a win ... **Neish** finished the season with a team-high six goals in her rookie campaign ... Junior **Catherine Czapski** added two goals in the win over the Cougars, while sophomores **Tenesha Corrales, Monika Derboghossian** and **Elyse Togliatti** each added a goal in the victory.



Thiel Tomcats (5-13-2, 1-8 PAC)

Against Westminster, Thiel notched the first goal of the contest just 44 seconds into regulation as freshman D **Nicole Jeschelning** found the back of the net to give Thiel the 1-0 lead which they would take into the half ... In the second half of play, Westminster dominated the pace and was able to score the equalizing goal just three minutes into the second frame when **Amanda Turi** found the net off a pass from **Tyler Dever** to notch the game at 1-1 ... The game would remain at 1-1 until the 89th minute of play when **Shanay Phillian** scored the go ahead goal for the Titans to take the game 2-1 ... The Tomcats then fell to the Geneva Golden Tornadoes 4-0 ... Freshman GK **Claire Fredriks** recorded six saves.



Thomas More Saints (10-4-1, 7-1-1 PAC)

Thomas More posted a 1-0-1 record last week as it defeated W&J, 0-0, in double overtime and defeated Waynesburg, 5-0 ... Sophomore M **Kirstie Reilman** led the team in scoring with four points on two goals ... Junior M **Chrissy Sonderman**, freshman F **Kelsea Arvin** and senior M **Sara Harrison** each added one goal last week ... Senior GK **Katie Burger** played all 200 minutes in goal and didn't allow a goal, while recording five saves and two shutouts ... For the season, sophomore F **Courtney Clark** leads the team in scoring with 24 points on 10 goals and four assists, while freshman M **Sam Work** is second with 16 points on seven goals and two assists.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents (14-3-1, 8-0-1 PAC)

W&J won its first PAC regular-season title in school history after defeating Bethany and tying Thomas More last week ... The Presidents are unbeaten in their last 13 games (12-0-1), the longest streak in school history ... W&J has 12 shutouts this season, one shy of the school record set in 2008 ... The Presidents were ranked No. 9 in last week's NSCAA Great Lakes Region poll ... Sophomore **Holly Shipley** scored her team-leading 12th goal against Bethany ... Freshman **Tatum Marucci** had a career-best four-point day against the Bison with one goal and two assists ... W&J will host Waynesburg in the PAC Tournament semifinals at 7 p.m. on Tuesday.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (14-4-1, 5-3-1 PAC)

Despite going 0-1-1 this past week, Waynesburg still had reason to celebrate this week as the Yellow Jackets qualified as the fourth seed for the PAC Tournament ... The Yellow Jackets played to a 0-0 tie with Bethany on Wednesday before falling at Thomas More on Saturday ... Waynesburg will travel to Washington & Jefferson to face the top-seeded Presidents on Tuesday ... When the two teams met up earlier this season, the Presidents pulled out a 2-1 double-overtime victory ... This will be Waynesburg's first trip to the conference tournament since it went to its current four-team format in 2005.



Westminster Titans (7-10-1, 5-4 PAC)

Westminster used two second-half goals to come back from a 1-0 deficit to win 2-1 at Thiel Wednesday before the Titans were eliminated from contention for a spot in the PAC tournament with a 2-0 loss at home vs. Grove City on Saturday ... Senior M **Shanay Phillian** scored the game-winner vs. Thiel with just 1:36 left in regulation after sophomore F **Amanda Turi** tied the game with a goal in the 47th minute ... Junior GK **Jenn Cantella** made one save after allowing a Thiel goal in the opening minute ... **Cantella** made nine saves vs. Grove City, who scored in the ninth and 88th minutes.
