# **KATIE MOUND Thiel College**

Sophomore midfielder Newton Falls, Ohio/Southeast H.S.

Mound led the Tomcats to a 2-0 week last week with three goals and an assist, leading Thiel to the #3 seed in this week's PAC Tournament. She scored two goals and added an assist in an 8-0 blanking of Lake Erie, then added a goal in a 3-1 PAC win over Bethany. Mound is tied for the team lead in goals with 11 and is second in points with 28 (11 goals, six assists).

Also nominated was senior MF Missy Gibson of Bethany, junior F Meg Tilley of Grove City, and senior D Krissy Edmonds of Westminster.

# Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of PAC games after dropping a non-conference tilt at Pitt-Greensburg ... In the W&J victory, senior Missy Gibson scored her 40th career goal, which also gives her 100 career points, to give the Bison the win ... Against Thiel, Brianna Brancazio cut the 2-0 Lady Cat lead in half with a score in the 15th minute ... But Thiel held off the Bison and clinched the third seed for the PAC Tournament ... Bethany will go into the Tournament as the #5 seed and travel to W&J, who the Green and White split a pair of games with during the regular season ... The Bison have won five Conference titles, with the last one coming in 1999.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped its final two PAC contests last week, falling to Bethany at home, 1-0, and Westminster in New Wilmington on Saturday, 8-0 ... The Presidents outshot the Bison, 13-6; however, BC's Missy Gibson scored on a breakaway with 18 minutes left for the game's lone goal ... Sophomore goalkeeper Gretchen Weber made three first-half saves for W&J ... The Presidents will look to avenge last week's loss to Bethany as they host the Bison on Tuesday evening at 7 pm at Cameron Stadium in the first round of the PAC Tournament ... Washington & Jefferson took the first meeting at Bethany, 3-2, on October 10th ... senior forward Quinn Mangis scored the game-winning goal for W&J in the second half.

# **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City is 10-1-2 in its last 13 games and undefeated in its last seven ... Meg Tilley, the PAC's leading scorer, rang up four goals last week, including two against Penn State Behrend in a two-minute span ... Tilley and Stacey Brubaker both scored in the victory at Waynesburg while goalkeepers Katy Turman and Lindsay Thompson combined for the shutout.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost its fifth straight to end the regular season after Saturday's 2-0 loss to Grove City ... The Jackets were outshot 26-1, as Waynesburg goalkeeper **Lindsay Acker** recorded 24 saves, while sophomore midfielder **Jackie Sassaman** put the lone shot on goal ... Waynesburg enters the PAC Tournament Tuesday at the No. 6 seed, and will travel to Thiel to play the No. 3-seeded Tomcats.

## **Thiel Tomcats**

The Thiel women's soccer team went 2-0 last week with an 8-0 shutout victory over Lake Erie College and a 3-1 win over Bethany on Senior Day ... Against Lake Ertie, senior Jess Peterson finished with two goals and two assists, while sophomore Katie Mound and freshman Ashleigh Dunsmore each had a pair of goals ... Sophomore GK Kristen Benjamin and Dunsmore split the shutout for the Tomcats, their fifth of the season ... Sophomore Laura Simonetti, Mound and Dunsmore each had goals in Thiel's victory over Bethany Saturday ... Benjamin made six stops in the win ... Number three Thiel will host number six Waynesburg on Tuesday at 3 p.m. in the PAC Women's Soccer Tournament.

## Westminster Titans

Westminster enters the PAC Tournament as the top seed with a first round bye and homefield advantage throughout the tournament ... The Lady Titans closed the regular season on a school-record 12game unbeaten streak (10-0-2) ... Last week, WC played Grove City to a 1-1 tie before closing the regular season with an 8-0 shutout of W&J ... Senior F Tammy Newell scored the lone goal against GCC with four minutes to play, after the Lady Wolverines had taken a 1-0 lead early in the second half ... Senior F Katie Krone had two goals and three assists against the Presidents ... Westminster earned its first-ever Division III Great Lakes regional ranking last week at #7.
