PAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week

MICHELLE NOVOSEL

Grove City College

Junior forward

New Wilmington, Pa./Wilmington Area H.S.

Novosel led GCC to a 3-0 week, including a pair of PAC wins as the Lady Wolverines posted the first 10-0 season in PAC women's soccer history. She had three assists on a 5-0 win over Waynesburg, giving her a school-record 12 assists this season. She also scored the game-tying goal and assisted on the game-winner in a 2-1 OT win over La Roche.

Also nominated was senior F Megan Maloney of Bethany, freshman F Holly Schaefer of Thiel, freshman F Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli of Washington & Jefferson, and junior MF Jen Raub of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany finished its regular season with a 1-2 week and enters the PAC Tournament as the fifth seed ... In the Thiel win, Bethany rebounded from an early goal to score two first half goals for the 2-1 win ... Brianna Brancazio scored with an assist from F Megan Maloney to tie the game and then Maloney scored what would be the game winner in the 36th minute off an assist from Abby Sacco ... In the Frostburg and Grove City losses, Bethany was outshot by a combined total of 55-5 but played hard in keeping within two goals in both ... The Bison will open the Pac Tournament at Thiel, where BC just pulled out a win less than a week ago.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents tied a school record for wins in a season on Friday by defeating Thiel, 5-1, in Greenville ... W&J tied the record set by the 1997 squad, which finished the season with a 10-8 overall record ... Junior mf Carrie Pazehoski scored the lone W&J goal in a 3-1 loss to Westminster on Tuesday ... Freshman F Maria Loffreda-Mancinelli netted a hat trick and added one assist on Friday to lead W&J past the Tomcats ... Sophomore F Jen Pergola and Toni Lynn Simonini added one goal and one assist apiece ... Pergola scored twice in the first half and sophomore MF Rachel Campbell added a late first-half score as W&J raced out to a 3-0 halftime lead Saturday, only to see Pitt-Greensburg score three of its own in the second half to earn the tie ... Pergola has now scored 17 goals.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City extended its school-record win streak to 14 last week with three victories ... Grove City also capped the first-ever 10-0 season in PAC women's soccer history, surpassing Westminster's 9-0-1 mark in 2002 ... Diane Metzger collected two goals against Waynesburg as Grove City out-shot the Jackets 47-1 ... Michelle Novosel assisted on three goals, then had a hand in both goals at La Roche ... Novosel tied the match in the 71st minute, then fed Meg Tilley for the game-winner 3:15 into OT ... It is Novosel's school-record 12th assist of the season ... Goalkeepers Lindsay Thompson and Kori Koper have combined for eight shutouts, tying the school record set in 1995 ... GCC is aiming for its sixth PAC title since 1995 and a second straight trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is winless in its last 11 games and scoreless in its last eight games after losing at Grove City (5-0) and at home against Westminster (3-0) last week ... The Jackets were outshot by Grove City, 47-1, as senior goalkeeper Lindsay Acker made 27 saves ... Waynesburg hasn't won a regular season PAC game since Oct. 5, 2001, and is 0-21-3 during that stretch ... The Jackets travel to Washington & Jefferson Monday for the first round of the PAC Tournament as the No. 6 seeded team.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-2 last week ... The Tomcats picked up their seventh win with a 3-0 blanking of non-conference foe Lake Erie before falling to PAC rivals Bethany (1-2) and W&J (1-5) ... Freshman F Holly Schaefer netted her seventh goal of the season against Lake Erie, while freshman F Lindsay Cimino and junior MF Laura Simonetti also tallied scored ... Sophomore GK Ashleigh Dunsmore recorded her fifth shutout of the season, setting a new Tomcat single-season mark ... Schaefer scored in the 14th minute against Bethany on a Simonetti assist, but the Bison responded with a pair of first-half goals to claim the victory ... W&J scored four first-half goals, led by Maria Loffreda's hat trick, in its 5-1 win over the Tomcats in their final PAC regular-season game.

Westminster Titans

Westminster closed the regular season last week with PAC road wins at W&J (3-1) and Waynesburg (3-0) ... At W&J, three WC goals came in a span of 4:36 in the second half ... Junior F Angie DePascale scored off an assist by senior MF Alyssa Pyle to open the scoring ... After W&J tied the game 1-1, the Lady Titans retook the lead for good as Pyle scored off an assist by junior MF Jen Raub ... Senior MF Alicia Anderson added an insurance goal, also assisted by Raub ... Junior GK Nicole Drummond made eight saves ... At Waynesburg, Anderson scored first on a Raub assist, followed by a goal by freshman MF Courtney Thompson assisted by junior MF Stephanie Toth ... Drummond closed the scoring, assisted by freshman F Christa Andamasaris ... Junior GK Laura Vollmer made one save in the shutout.
