# PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE (PAC) 2009 WOMEN'S SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT - November 3-7, 2009

## <u>Semifinal #1 - Tuesday, November 3</u> #1 GROVE CITY 2, #4 WESTMINSTER 0

Grove City College - Grove City, Pa. - 2 p.m.

The top-seeded Grove City Wolverines advanced to host the 2009 PAC Championship match by shutting out the visiting Titans. Grove City broke a scoreless tie at the 16:41 mark as Westminster scored an "own goal." GCC senior Michelle Peck (Abingdon, Md./Bel Air H.S.) sent a corner kick into the box and the ball deflected off the shoulder of a Westminster defender and went into the net. The Wolverines added an insurance goal at 63:26 as sophomore Arielle Goyzueta (Goshen, N.Y./Goshen H.S.) booted a rebound into the goal for her fourth goal of 2009. Senior GK Bethany Preston (Elma, N.Y./ Iroquois) preserved the shutout by stopping four shots to help give the Wolverines' their ninth shutout of the season. Grove City out-shot Westminster 11-8 and also held a 7-3 edge in corner kicks. Freshman GK Jenn Cantella (Fredom, Pa./ **Freedom H.S.)** stopped four shots in the loss for Westminster. which dropped to 13-7-1 overall.

#### Semifinal #2 - Tuesday, November 3 #3 WASH. & JEFF. 2, #2 THOMAS MORE 1 (2OT)

Thomas More College - Crestview Hills, Ky. - 3 p.m.

The defending PAC champion Presidents outlasted the Saints in double-overtime to advance to the 2009 PAC title match at Grove City Saturday. W&J took an early 1-0 lead when sophomore M Elizabeth Bendick (Yonkers, N.Y./ Handley H.S.) scored off an assist from Hannah Shaner at the 8:18 mark. The Presidents kept the 1-0 at halftime. Then at the 80:11 mark, senior D Kaitlyn Cohen (Cincinnati, Ohio/Seton H.S.) tied the match at 1-1 when she scored on a free kick from 24-yards out. The two teams remained tied through the rest of regulation and the first overtime period. W&J senior Molly Macioce (DuBois, Pa./Laurel Highlands H.S.) scored the Presidents' game-winning goal at the 104:33 mark from 20yards out. The two teams were tied 15-15 in shots, but Thomas More won the battle of corner kicks, 5-4. For the Presidents, sophomore GK Stephanie Saussol (Pittsburgh, Pa./ Baldwin H.S.) made a pair of saves in the victory. TMC senior GK Jenna Kramer (Cincinnati, Ohio/Seton H.S.) recorded six saves in the loss, whose season ends at 15-3-1 overall.

## 2009 PAC Championship - Saturday, November 7 #3 Washington & Jefferson 3, #1 GROVE CITY 0

Grove City College - Grove City, Pa. - 1 p.m.

Freshman M Chrissy Marcius (North Huntingdon, Pa./ Norwin) scored the game's only goal as the Washington & Jefferson women's soccer team successfully defended its PAC Championship after defeating host Grove City, 1-0, in the tournament championship match Saturday at College Field.

The Presidents (12-6-2) earned their first win at Grove City since the 2005 season and receive the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive season. For the second-straight year, W&J won both its semifinal and championship matches on the road.

Third-seeded W&J and top-seeded GCC (11-6-3) played a scoreless first half with the Wolverines holding a 7-3 advantage in shots, while W&J held the slight edge in corner kicks, 2-1.

The Wolverines continued to hold an edge in the stat sheet in the second half, but Marcius converted on a scoring opportunity in the 60th minute to put the Presidents in front for good.

W&J sophomore GK Stephanie Saussol (Pittsburgh, Pa./Baldwin H.S.) held the Wolverines off the scoreboard the rest of the way and finished the contest with 10 saves. Saussol recorded her sixth shutout of the season. GCC goalie Bethany Preston (Elma, N.Y./Iroquois H.S.) collected five stops.
