After a scoreless first half, the Tomcats scored a pair of second half goals to advance to the semifinal round. Sophomore **Katie Mound (Newton Falls, OH/Southeast H.S.)** scored in the 64th minute off an assist by junior midfielder **Ashley Wheeler (Fayetteville, NY/Fayetteville-Manius H.S.)** for a 1-0 lead. Wheeler then assisted on an insurance goal by senior **Jess Peterson (Greenville, PA/Reynolds H.S.)** in the 77th minute. Sophomore **Kristen Benjamin (Kent, OH/Kent Roosevelt H.S.)** made four saves to earn the shutout, while Waynesburg goalkeeper **Lindsey Acker (Beaver, PA/Beaver H.S.)** made six saves in the loss.

The Presidents scored all three goals in the opening half, as W&J advanced to the semifinals with a shutout win over the Bison. Freshman forward **Toni Lynn Simonini (Washington, PA/Trinity H.S.)** scored in the game's fifth minute on an assist by classmate **Sandy Simoneaux (Dharan, Saudi Arabia/Western Reserve H.S.)**.
