The Bison began the 2003 season with a 5-4 win over Waynesburg ... The match with Frostburg State scheduled for Sept. 2 was moved to Sept. 24 ... Junior Katie Navarra won at #1 singles (6-4, 6-1) and doubles (playing with Beth Wichrowski for an 8-4 victory) ... Hillary Norman and Lindsey Caparese teamed for an 8-5 triumph at #2 doubles and also won their singles matches ... Norman cruised in her singles match, 6-2, 6-0 at #2 ... Caparese stepped up with a big win at #4 ... As the last remaining match, her 6-3, 6-3 win gave Bethany the victory over the Yellow Jackets.

Washington & Jefferson fell to Westminster in New Wilmington on Saturday by a 6-3 score ... The Presidents were led by junior Katy Petousis, who won both of her matches in singles and doubles play ... Petousis earned 7-5, 6-1, decision at No. 5 singles and then teamed with junior Cassandra Nicastro to win, 8-5, at No. 3 doubles ... Junior Terra Naviglia also won at No.3 singles, posting a 7-5, 3-6, 6-4 victory.

Grove City won its 65th straight conference match in a 9-0 triumph over host Thiel last Thursday ... The Lady Wolverines lost just two games to Thiel ...
