PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

Westminster College Senior - #1 singles/#1 doubles Pittsburgh, Pa./South Park H.S.

Muir earned the first PAC Player of the Week honor in women's tennis for 2002 after leading Westminster to a 2-0 week with wins over Penn State-Behrend (7-2) and PAC rival Washington & Jefferson (6-3). Muir was a perfect 3-0 on the week, winning in straight sets at #1 singles against PS-B, then sweeping the #1 singles and doubles slots against W&J.
