After a 5-0 loss to the host school, Bethany dropped a 4-1 decision to Chatham ... The lone win was earned by senior **Sarah Goho** by an 8-6 score at #4 singles ... BC wrapped up the weekend by dropping a 4-1 decision to Frostburg State ... Their win in that match came in the doubles contest, as sophomores **Ashley Current** and **Kathleen Thompson** scored an 8-0 win ... A busy week is on tap for the Bison, as they sandwich home matches against Geneva and Behrend around PAC contests at Grove City and Thomas More.

Chatham Cougars



Chatham dropped its first contest of the season against defending PAC champion Grove City College 0-9 ... Chatham bounced back to play well in the Penn State-Behrend Invitational where the Cougars placed fourth out of six teams ... Freshman **Barb Petty** moved into the Number 1 singles position during the Behrend Invitational and won all three of her matches on the day.
