In their first match of the season Wednesday, the Bison dropped a 6-3 decision to Westminster ... August Gardner and Smith accounted for all the team's wins, as they won their matches at #1 and #3 singles respectively and also teamed for a victory at #1 doubles.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's nine-match win streak came to an end last Wednesday as Division II West Liberty State nipped the Wolverines, 5-4 ... Sophomore **Erin Bennett** earned a pair of wins for Grove City, winning at both fifth singles

and third doubles ... Freshman Chris Sager won at sixth singles while Kristin McNally and Lindsey Hosler teamed for a win at second doubles ... the Presidents' Jules Novak at third singles.

O'Connell in third doubles ... The O'Connell/Hammond duo are completely opposite, as O'Connell is an 18-year-old junior while Hammond is a 28-year-old junior and mother of two.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J evened its record at 2-2 overall with a 2-1 record this week ... The Presidents, who played matches in three consecutive games, opened their PAC schedule with an 8-1 victory over Thiel Friday ... The Presidents claimed five of six singles matches and all three doubles contests ... Sophomore **Lisa McLaughlin** and freshman

Allison Gladish both recorded 6-0, 6-0 victories at No. 5 and No. 6 singles, respectively ... The win also signified Peter Moss' first triumph as head tennis coach at W&J ... McLaughlin and freshmen Martina Helfferich and Kerri DiGiovanni all won both their singles and doubles matches in a 6-3 victory over Ursuline ... In the loss to Westminster, W&J sophomore Missy Barnickel and Gladish claimed their No. 1 and No. 2 singles matches, respectively, and then teamed for an 8-5 triumph at No. 1 doubles.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets split a pair of matches this week ... In their weekend loss to Goucher, Waynesburg was swept in doubles before splitting the six singles matches ... Despite losing at No. 1 doubles against the Gophers, **Mindy Hall** and **Laura Garcia** rebounded to claim straight-set victories at No. 1 and No. 4 singles, respec-

tively ... Junior Beth Conlon posted the other victory at No. 2 singles ... In its first victory of the season, Waynesburg swept singles play in its sixth-straight victory over Frostburg State ... In singles action, three Yellow Jacket players posted victories with a score of 6-0, 6-0 ... Including in that mix was a victory by Garcia, whose victory was the first of her collegiate career ... Also posting her first victory in the college ranks was **Evelyn Fabian**, who recorded a 6-1, 6-1 victory at No. 6 singles.





Westminster opened the 2005 season on a positive note with three victories last week, as the Lady Titan netters posted non-league home wins over Bethany (6-3) and Frostburg State (7-2) before opening Presidents' Athletic Conference (PAC) play with a 5-4 decision at Washington & Jefferson ...
