Grubbs went 4-0 last week (2-0 at #4 singles, 2-0 at #3 doubles with classmate Amy Browell) to lead the Lady Titans to wins over Frostburg State (7-2) and PAC rival Washington & Jefferson (7-2).

Also nominated was junior **Hillary Norman** of Bethany, sophomore **Lindsay Hosler** of Grove City, and freshman **Katie Kravits** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison women's tennis team opened its season at the Penn State-Behrend Invitational and advanced to the championship match, falling to Alfred, 4-1 ... Prior to that, the Bison defeated Frostburg State and Allegheny by scores of 4-1 ... Hillary Norman went 3-0 at the tournament while playing second singles ... Against Allegheny, the Bison got wins from August Gardner and Ali Viveros in doubles and Norman, Lindsay Caparese and Carissa Moore in singles ... Against Frostburg the Bison swept the singles matches as Katie Navarra won at the No. 1 spot, while Norman, Gardner and Viveros also notched wins.
