PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

Grove City College Freshman - #5 singles/#3 doubles Lititz, Pa./Manheim Central H.S.

Holser was a perfect 4-0 on the week, winning singles and doubles contests against both Division II California (Pa.) and PAC rival W&J. She won all four matches in straight sets, surrendering just three games in the wins against CUP.

Also nominated was junior Katie Navarra of Bethany, junior Terra Naviglia of Washington & Jefferson, and junior Beth Grubbs of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany split a pair of matches before taking two of three at the Penn State Behrend Tournament... Freshman August Gardner won her singles match at #5 to give Bethany a 5-4 win over Westminster ... At the Behrend Tourney, Katie Navarra (9-7) and Hillary Norman (8-0) took singles matches but it wasn't enough against Division II Clarion ... Against Behrend, Navarra (8-4), Norman (8-1) and Lindsey Caparese (8-2) were victorious in singles matches to pace the Bison win ... The same three also won singles matches against Allegheny to carry Bethany to the win ... For the week, Navarra and Norman both went 4-1 in singles matches.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents opened their 2003 home schedule by defeating Thiel on Wednesday, 9-0, at the Swanson Tennis Courts ... W&J won all six singles matches in straight sets and dropped just two points in the three doubles matches ... Grove City then handed Washington & Jefferson an 8-1 setback on Friday in Washington ... Junior Terra Naviglia picked up the lone W&J victory at No. 3 singles, making her the first W&J women's tennis player to earn a point against the Lady Wolverines since 1994 (a total of seven matches) ... The Presidents hit the road for matches at Bethany and Waynesburg this week and also host Frostburg State on Friday.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City nearly knocked off Division II California, Pa. in the home opener before downing W&J 8-1 on Friday ... Freshman Lindsey Hosler was the only Lady Wolverine to go unbeaten in both singles and doubles action during the week, winning twice at fifth singles and third doubles ... First singles entry Allison Atwood and fourth singles player Julie Crewson each went 2-0 in singles action ... Grove City's match at Waynesburg Saturday was suspended due to rain with the Lady Wolverines owning a 2-0 lead ... The match will be finished Thursday at Grove City ... Rain also forced the postponement of Monday's scheduled PAC match between Bethany and Grove City until Wednesday, Sept. 17.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel women's tennis team dropped a pair of matches on the road last week ... The Tomcats fell to Penn State Altoona 0-9 on Sept. 8 and lost to W&J 0-9 on Sept. 10 ... Senior LeAnn Camp lost to PS-A's Nicole Maietta 1-6, 4-6 at number two singles and fell to W&J's Jennifer van Gorder 4-6, 0-6 at second singles.

Westminster Titans

The Lady Titan netters dropped a pair of matches last week, falling at PAC rival Bethany 5-4 on Tuesday before being swept 9-0 in a non-conference match at John Carroll on Friday ... Against the Bison, the two teams split six singles matches but Bethany won two of three doubles contests ...
