Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped a pair of home matches over the weekend, including their PAC opener against Thomas More ... The Saints defeated BC 8-1, with the lone victory coming from junior **Jen Hubbell** at #6 singles ... The 6-4, 7-6 (7-3) win was the first for Hubbell, who is in her first year on the team ... The Bison junior kept it up against Penn State-Behrend Sunday, as she won her second straight match with a 6-2, 7-5 triumph at #6 as Bethany dropped a 6-3 decision to the Lions ... Other Bethany winners against Penn State-Behrend included senior **Kati DeMundo** at #3 (3-6, 6-4, 10-7) and freshman **Ashley Current** at #1 (6-0, 6-2) ... It was also the first career singles victory for Current and DeMundo, who is also in her first year with the program.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened PAC play Saturday afternoon with a 9-0 sweep of Thomas More at the Grove City College Courts ... **Nicole Andreini, Julie Bellissimo, Erin Bennett, Kristin McNally** and **Tamara Nations** all earned a pair of wins during the match ... Freshman **Lisa Baldwin** won at fifth singles while **Lindsey Hosler** teamed with McNally for a win at second doubles ... Grove City opened the weekend by taking all three doubles matches with Waynesburg ... However, rain suspended the match before singles play began ... The teams will resume the match later this year at Waynesburg ... Grove City will host Carnegie Mellon Tuesday afternoon ... The Wolverines will trek to W&J for a PAC clash Wednesday.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More picked up two PAC wins this week, beating Bethany and Washington & Jefferson ... **Whitney Reis** (first singles), **Emily Prescott** (third singles), **Haley O'Connell** (fourth singles) and **Monica Pharo** (fifth singles) all posted 2-1 records this week ... All fell as TMC was swept at Grove City ... Reis has a team-high three wins and is 3-1 on the season ... The Saints will step away from PAC play Thursday to play interstate-rival Mt. St. Joseph.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson remained winless after falling to PAC rival Thomas More 7-2 Saturday and dropping a 9-0 decision on Sunday at Case Western Reserve ... The Presidents have now lost two matches by 9-0 counts in their first three contests ... W&J looks to pick up its first win of the 2006 season this week as it hosts Waynesburg on Tuesday and Grove City on Wednesday.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets were scheduled to open PAC play on Friday with their match against Grove City, however, rain suspended the match after doubles play ... The Wolverines swept all three doubles matches before the match was suspended ... Waynesburg continued its weekend road trip on Saturday when it played Penn State-Behrend, losing to the Lions 7-2 ... Senior **Sara DePiano** posted both wins in the match for the Yellow Jackets, winning in straight-set at No. 5 singles and teaming with freshman **Allie Horochak** for an 8-3 win at No. 3 doubles ... Freshman **Lindsay English** played a three-set match at No. 6 singles, winning the first set before falling in the second and third sets.



Westminster Titans

Westminster lost a pair of matches Saturday in the Allegheny Tournament ... The Titans lost to the host Gators, 6-3, before dropping a 5-4 decision against Case Western Reserve ... Singles winners against Allegheny were freshman **April Scudere** and sophomore **Alyson Lingle** at No. 4 and 6, respectively ... Westminster (2-3) also won No. 3 doubles with the tandem of senior **Sara Belsito** and junior **Trista Houck** claiming the win, 9-8 (7-4) ... Belsito and Houck were also victorious in their doubles match against CWRU, this time at No. 2 doubles, 8-2 ... The Titans also won the final three singles positions ... Scudere won in straight sets at No. 4, senior **Andrea Pastorius** gutted out a three-set win at No. 5 and Lingle won in straight sets at No. 6 ... Scudere and Lingle are the first Titans to reach four singles wins on the year.



Saint Vincent Bearcats

Saint Vincent captured the Nancy Heath Invitational at Allegheny College on Saturday, defeating Case Western in the first round and host Allegheny in the championship ... The team then swept PSU-Altoona at home on Sunday ... #2 singles player **Lori Orthen**, age 43, is 5-2 in singles matches this season and 6-1 when paired with **Meghan Wells** in the #1 doubles spot ... **Ashley Nord** and **Ashley Oglione** are each carrying records of 6-1 in singles play ...
