Bethany Bison

The Bison captured their first PAC win of the season last Thursday with a 6-3 victory over W&J ... Seniors **Hillary Norman** and **Lindsay Caparese** and junior **Alejandra Viveros** all won in singles and doubles to pace the triumph ... Norman and Caparese teamed for an 8-2 win at #1 doubles, while Viveros and **Katie Erdy** claimed an 8-5 victory at #3 doubles ... In singles play, Norman highlighted the action with a 6-0, 6-0 victory at #1, while Caparese (6-3, 6-1), **August Gardner** (6-1, 6-1) and Viveros (6-2, 6-3) took victories at second through fourth singles ... The Bison were slated to play Grove City Friday but the match was postponed by rain and rescheduled for Sept. 30 at Grove City.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City won the Allegheny Heath Invitational Saturday by posting 7-2 victories over Case Western and Allegheny ... The Wolverines went a combined 6-0 in doubles matches ... Freshman **Tamara Nations** went 2-0 at second singles while senior **Julie Crewson** went 2-0 at third singles ... Grove City also went 2-0 at sixth singles at Allegheny as senior **Jenna Powell** and freshman **Chris Sager** both won matches ... Crewson and Nations team for two victories at first singles ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 9-0 sweep of Westminster ... Grove City won all three doubles matches by 8-0 scores ... Nations did not yield a game at second singles ... Grove City's Sept. 16 home match with Bethany has been rescheduled for Sept. 30.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel posted an overall mark of 0-2 last week ... The Tomcats fell 8-1 at Penn State Altoona on Monday before suffering a 9-0 home loss to Waynesburg in their PAC opener on Wednesday ... Sophomores **Sarah Barefoot** and **Ashley Crothers** recorded their first win of the season at number one singles, defeating PSA's **JoAnna Paul** and **Brianna Alianello** 8-6.



Thomas More Saints

Juniors **Whitney Reis** and **Haley O'Connell**, along with sophomore **Alma Murga**, picked up their first wins of the season in Thomas More's 5-4 loss to Berea ... Reis and Murga teamed for Thomas More's lone doubles win in the match ... Thomas More won just five sets in dropping a 9-0 decision to Bellarmine, and O'Connell won four of those five.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Bethany captured four of six singles matches and two of three doubles contests to earn a 6-3 victory over Washington & Jefferson Thursday ... The Presidents were led by sophomore **Lisa McLaughlin** and freshman **Kerri DiGiovanni**, who recorded the only team points in singles play ... McLaughlin edged BC's **Katie Erdy** (6-3, 6-2) at No. 6 singles, while DiGiovanni picked up a 6-2, 6-4 victory over **Erica Smith** at the No. 5 position ... In doubles play, sophomore **Jules Novak** and freshman **Martina Helfferich** earned an 8-4 decision at the No. 2 slot ... W&J was scheduled to play Chatham Saturday in Washington; however, that match has been postponed until Tuesday at 4 p.m.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg started the week with victories over Penn State-Behrend, 5-3, and Thiel, 9-0, before suffering a loss to St. Vincent, 6-3, Saturday ... In the loss to the Bearcats, the Yellow Jackets posted victories in the first three-seeded singles matches ... Junior **Beth Conlon** posted her team-best fifth singles victory at No. 2 ... In the PAC opener against Thiel, Waynesburg swept doubles play to take a 3-0 lead into singles play, where it again posted a sweep ... All six Yellow Jacket posted multiple victories in the conference match ... Despite losing two doubles matches to Behrend, the Yellow Jackets rebounded to post four victories in singles action to claim a victory ... Conlon and classmate **Jenn Knight** posted the lone victory in doubles action, while both recorded wins in singles play.
