PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

KATIE KRAVITS Waynesburg College

Freshman - #1-2 singles/#1 doubles Gibsonia, Pa./Pine-Richland H.S.

Kravits was instrumental for the 3-0 Yellow Jackets last week. She fought off two match points en route to a three-set win at #2 doubles in a 6-3 win over Bethany, while overcoming a 6-1 deficit to win 9-8 at #1 doubles vs. the Bison. At Allegheny, she won in a three-set tiebreaker to break a 4-4 tie and give Waynesburg a 5-4 win. She also won at #1 singles in a 8-1 win vs. Frostrburg State.

Also nominated was senior **Katie Navarra** of Bethany, sophomore **Lindsay Hosler** of Grove City, senior **Terra Naviglia** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior **Amy Browell** of Westminster.

PAC WOMEN'S TENNIS NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 0-2 last week, falling to PAC foes Westminster and Waynesburg ... The Bison traveled to Westminster Tuesday and fell 5-4 ... Katie Navarra got things started for the Bison with a 6-2, 6-4 victory at first singles ... Hillary Norman and August Gardner followed with wins at No. 2 and 3 ... Norman won 6-0, 6-1, while Gardner won 6-2, 7-6 (4) ... Navarra and Norman won first doubles, but the Titans won second and third doubles to earn the victory ... Later in the week, BC and Waynesburg finished a match that was started on Sept. 7, but was postponed due to rain ... The Jackets won the match, 5-3. Winning for Bethany was Navarra at No. 1 singles, Gardner at No. 3 and Caparese at No. 4.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J earned its first victory of the season after shutting out Thiel, 9-0, on Monday in Greenville ... The Presidents claimed five of the six singles matches in straight sets and also won all three doubles matches by a combined score of 24-5 ... Senior Cassandra Nicastro and sophomore Jennifer O'Hara both won by 6-0, 6-0 margins at No. 6 and No. 5 singles positions, respectively ... Nicastro also teamed with senior Katy Petousis to win, 8-0, at No. 3 doubles ... Seniors Jennifer Scott (No. 1) and Terra Naviglia (No. 2) were the lone Presidents to win singles matches in the loss to Saint Vincent ... In doubles play, seniors Nicastro and Petousis recorded an 8-6 victory at the No. 2 position.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City split a pair of matches against NCAA Division II foes last week by identical 5-4 scores ... Sophomore Lindsay Hosler and senior Nicole Leasure were both double-winners against West Liberty ... Hosler and freshman Kristin McNally each picked up two victories against Clarion Thursday ... Grove City won three of the six singles matches both days but could only claim one doubles win against Clarion ... The Wolverines' Sept. 22 match at Bethany has been switched to Grove City ... Grove City will now travel to Bethany Oct. 14 ... Julie Crewson, Hosler, Megan Hulick and McNally will play in the ITA Championships at Mary Washington College this weekend.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg rebounded strong after a rough 0-3 start ... This week, with the completion of the match against Bethany, the Yellow Jackets posted three consecutive wins and are now 3-3 ... Freshman Katie Kravits was instrumental in the wins over Bethany and Allegheny ... She saved two match points against Hillary **Norman** before winning 6-4, 4-6, 7-6 (7-0) at No. 2 singles and teamed with Mindy Hall to come back from 1-6 to win 9-8 (10-8) at No. 1 doubles versus Bethany ... At Allegheny, Kravits won 6-3, 2-6, 7-6 (7-3) with the team score tied at 4-4 to earn the win in dramatic fashion ... The No. 3 doubles team of Rebecca Greene and Sara DePiano contributed three points in each of the three recent wins.
