Grove City notched a pair of victories last week, including a 7-2 win at Wooster Saturday ... Sophomore Jenna Powell also recorded two wins on Saturday at Wooster while Allison Atwood and Julie Crewson each won singles matches ... Hosler and Powell are undefeated at third doubles this fall ... Grove City will close the season with three home matches, including PAC matches against Westminster and Washington and Jefferson ... The Lady Wolverines will participate in ITA competition this weekend at Mary Washington College.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg had a busy weekend improving to 6-3 overall ... On Saturday, the Jackets defeated W&J, 8-1, for their first PAC win of the season ... On Sunday, Waynesburg won the Shenandoah Fall Classic with wins over Frostburg State, 9-0, and Shenandoah, 8-1 ... Waynesburg began the week on Thursday losing to Grove City, 7-1, in a match that was finished from Sept. 13 because of rain ... The match, officially won by Grove City, will be completed at the PAC Championships for seeding purposes ... During the wins over the weekend, sophomore Mindy Hall went 3-0 in singles matches and 2-0 in doubles ... She won No. 2 singles matches against W&J and Shenandoah, while her singles win against Frostburg State was at No. 1.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel fell to 0-4 on the season last week after losing to PAC rival Westminster 8-0 ...
