#### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany split a pair of PAC matches last week, losing to Grove City and beating W&J on the road ... The Bison were swept by GCC, although senior Lauren **DeMundo** lost a tough match at #5 singles in three sets (6-4, 3-6, 4-6) ... In claiming the victory over W&J, two doubles teams and five singles players recorded wins ... Sophomore Katie Navarra and senior Sami Kennedy (8-3) and freshman Lindsay Caparese and DeMundo (9-7) won at #1 and #3 doubles ... In singles action, Navarra at #1 (6-1, 4-6, 6-0), freshman Hillary Norman at #2 (6-0, 7-6), Kennedy at #3 (6-3, 6-3), DeMundo at #5 (6-4, 6-1) and junior Beth Wichrowski at #6 (6-2, 6-1) picked up wins.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson dropped two PAC matches last week, before ending the losing skid with a 6-3 victory over Chatham on Saturday ... Sophomore Terra Naviglia won four of her five matches during the week ... She picked up two wins in doubles play and won both of her singles matches during the week vs. Bethany and Waynesburg ... Sophomores Lauren Latuska and Jennifer Scott also won two of their three No. 1 doubles matches during the week.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

The Lady Wolverines improved to 3-0 in the conference with their third sweep of the year last Monday ... Allison Atwood remained unbeaten at both first singles and first doubles while Lisa Oriti stayed perfect at second singles and first doubles ... Grove City has won 63 consecutive conference matches to go along with 15 straight PAC titles ... Against Wooster, Grove City won five of six singles matches and two of three doubles contests ... After opening the season with three straight home matches, the Lady Wolverines are in the middle of six consecutive road matches ... The Lady Wolverines are 2-0 away from Grove City.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After a sluggish start, Waynesburg notched its first win of the season against Washington & Jefferson, 5-3, on Tuesday ... Andrea Custer and Mindy Hall captured the No. 1 and 2 doubles matches ... The Tomcats finished last week 0-4, dropping a 9-0 conference decision to Westminster ... Senior **Anna Schultz** earned two victories at her number one singles spot last week and teamed with sophomore **Alison Kuder** to win three matches at number one doubles ...
