Grove City dropped a 9-0 decision to visiting Carnegie Mellon Tuesday at the GCC Courts ... Freshman Nicole Andreini dropped a 6-0, 7-5 decision to defending ITA national champion Amy Staloch at first singles ... Four play-

ers competed in the ITA Southeast Regional Championships in Fredericksburg, Va., this weekend ... Andreini advanced to Monday morning's Championship singles consolation semifinals ... Sophomore Tamara Nations went 1-2 in the Championship singles draw before being eliminated ...
