In the loss to the Bearcats, the closest match of the day was at #1 singles, where freshman **Ashley Current** dropped a 6-3, 6-1 decision ... This will be a busy week for the Green and White, with four matches in a span of six days beginning Tuesday ... Bethany will take on conference rivals Waynesburg and W&J early in the week, before facing Frostburg State Saturday and Westminster Sunday.



## Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a 9-0 decision to visiting Carnegie Mellon Tuesday at the GCC Courts ... Freshman **Nicole Andreini** dropped a 6-0, 7-5 decision to defending ITA national champion **Amy Staloch** at first singles ... Four players competed in the ITA Southeast Regional Championships in Fredericksburg, Va., this weekend ... Andreini advanced to Monday morning's Championship singles consolation semifinals ... Sophomore **Tamara Nations** went 1-2 in the Championship singles draw before being eliminated ... Senior **Lindsey Hosler** went 1-1 in the Blue singles draw while **Kristin Taylor** (1-2) was ousted in the Blue consolation bracket ... Andreini and Nations went 1-1 in the Championship doubles draw ... Hosler and Taylor opened with a loss in Blue doubles action but worked back to the consolation semifinals.

In the loss to the Yellow Jackets, sophomore **Allison Johnston** posted the Presidents' only singles victory at the No. 1 position after posting a 6-4, 6-3 victory ...
