PAC Women's Tennis Player of the Week

Senior - #6 singles/#3 doubles Rochester, N.Y./Irondequoit H.S.

Powell won the ITA Southeast Region Gray Singles Draw on Sunday in Fredericksburg, Va., by posting a 4-0 singles mark over the weekend. Earlier in the week, she posted a win at sixth singles in a 9-0 sweep of PAC rival W&J and teamed with Erin Bennett for a win at third singles in a 9-0 win over league foe Thiel.

Also nominated was senior **Lindsay Caparese** of Bethany, sophomore **Allison Johnston** of Washington & Jefferson, junior **Jenn Knight** of Waynesburg, and junior **Betsy Nolan** of Westminster.

Bethany went 2-1 last week, including splitting a pair of PAC matches ... The Bison were upended by Waynesburg 6-3 Tuesday, despite Hillary Norman and Lindsay Caprarese teaming for a win at #1 doubles and both winning

singles matches ... BC then blanked Frostburg State 9-0 Thursday, their second win of the year over the Bobcats ... Senior **Erica Smith** teamed with **August Gardner** for an 8-2 triumph at #2 doubles and then breezed to a 6-1, 6-0 victory at #5 singles ... In the win over Thomas More, junior **Katie Erdy** combined with **Alejandra Viveros** for a win at #3 doubles and then blanked her opponent at #6 singles 6-0, 6-0 ... Norman and Caprarese both went 3-0 for the week in singles and doubles action.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped three matches last week, losing at home to Grove City Monday (0-9), at Ursuline (2-7) Wednesday and at home to Westminster (9-0) on Thursday ... Against Ursuline, senior **Elizabeth Sensenstein** and freshman **Deidra Fraley** posted an 8-7 (8-6)

win over **Nicole McConnell** and **Elois McElrath** at first doubles ... Sensenstein also earned a 7-6 (7-5), 6-1 win at second singles over **Danielle Robinson**.



Grove City Wolverines

Senior Jenna Powell captured the Gray singles draw title at the ITA Southeast Regional Championships Sunday afternoon by going 4-0 over the weekend ... She went 3-0 Sunday and won all four matches in straight

sets ... Sophomore **Erin Bennett** went 2-2 in the Blue singles draw while the Bennett-Powell doubles team went 1-1 ... **Tamara Nations** went 1-1 in singles action at the ITA tournament ... Grove City ran its overall win streak to five with a pair of 9-0 sweeps in PAC action last week ... Grove City dropped just two games Monday at Thiel ... Grove City won five of the six singles matches 6-0, 6-0 ... At Washington and Jefferson Thursday, Nations, freshman **Chris Sager** and sophomore **Kristin McNally** each won 6-0, 6-0 in singles play.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson picked up victories over Chatham (8-1) and Westminster (6-3) this week, but dropped a 9-0 decision to Grove City ... The win over the Lady Titans avenged a 5-4 loss earlier in the season ... The Presidents started the match with three wins in doubles play and the claimed five of the six singles contests to run away

with the win over Chatham ... At No. 3 singles, freshman **Martina Helfferich** recorded a 6-0, 6-0 victory ... Sophomore **Allison Johnston** notched the top victory versus Westminster as he posted a 6-2, 6-2 win at No. 2 singles ... The W&J-Thiel match scheduled for Monday has been postponed to Wednesday in Washington due to inclement weather.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

third doubles ... With a 2-0 lead, the Jackets continued their decisive play and collected four consecutive straight-set wins ...
